BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR (BBE) CLASS ELIGIBILITY

1. All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC.
2. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
3. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

CRC JUDGE'S AWARD

At the Judge's discretion, CRC Judge's Awards will be awarded to a maximum of 10% of the Best of Breed Entry, including Winners Dog and Winners Bitch and Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch, with no limitations as to the sex. The 10% is in **addition** to the two CRC Judge's Awards automatically awarded to the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex Winners.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran Dogs, 7 yrs. & older Veteran Bitches, 7 yrs. & older

Note: Neutered dogs and spayed bitches will be allowed to compete in the Veteran Class.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another Class. The Stud Dog

must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. **
Brood Bitch Class - Same as above except substitute Brood Bitch For Stud Dog and Produce for Get. **

Brace Class - Two dogs presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. Dogs may be entered for Brace competition ONLY. The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only."**

***As the judges decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible for Best of Breed Competition by virtue of having won any of these classes.*

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: For Boys and Girls 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For Boys and Girls 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Note: There will be no refund of entry fees for Bitches entered in Obedience that come into season after entries close.

Graduate Novice Class - For dogs that have obtained the AKC title CD and have not received a qualifying score toward a CDX Title prior to the closing of entries. Dogs in this class may be handled by owner or any other person. Dogs entered in this class may also be entered in one of the Open Classes. The exercise shall be judged as in the Novice Class, except that the Heel Free with the Figure Eight, Drop on Recall, Long Sit and Down exercises will be performed in the Open Class.

Veterans Class - For dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 or more years on the date of the trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice class. Dogs may be entered in another class or classes.

Brace Class - For any two Rottweilers that are otherwise eligible under the Obedience Regulations, not necessarily owned by the same person, but handled by one handler. The Novice Class exercises will be used and the Brace should work in unison at all times. Dogs may be entered for Brace Competition Only. The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry.


– NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS FOR BOTH EVENTS –

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The AKC will collect a \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee and 50 cent Recording Fee for the first entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Event/Recording Fees to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule. Ch. 11, Sec. 2). In accordance with AKC Rally regulations, the AKC will collect a \$3.00 per entry of dog Rally Event Service Fee. A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for AKC.
- **CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS**
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or its Show Secretary, or BaRay Events assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. BaRay Events will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify BaRay Events at (360) 683-1507 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.

THE FUTURITY STAKE IS OPEN TO ROTTWEILER BREEDERS IN GOOD STANDING WITH THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB. ALSO, THE FUTURITY IS OPEN ONLY TO LITTERS FROM PARENTS WHO WERE TWO YEARS OF AGE AND OFA HIP CERTIFIED PRIOR TO THE DATE THE BREEDING TOOK PLACE.

Any breeder who, having nominated a litter, fails to remain in good standing with the AKC and has not been reinstated 30 days prior to the Futurity shall lose all rights in the ARC Futurity. The Futurity Stake is entered by nominating the litter. The get from this litter are eligible to compete in the first annual Futurity Stake held on or after the date they reach six months of age, and only in this stake.

In this stake there will be 43 cash wins, the three individuals (the breeder, the owner, and the owner of the sire at the time of nomination) partaking of these awards, for a total of 88 monetary awards, won by 40 different Rottweilers.

Ten Percent shall be deducted from the total nomination and entry fee purse to be used for Futurity expenses. This will be known as the General Expense Fund. This Fund shall be used to cover all expenses incurred by the Futurity Stake, i.e., judges, printing, mailing, etc. Since the administrative and judging expense will vary from year to year, excess in any given year shall be carried for use in future years.

Twenty-five percent shall be deducted from the total nomination and entry fee purse to be awarded as follows: 15% to the Best in Futurity, 5% to the Best Senior in Futurity, and 5% to the Best Junior in Futurity. The 15% Best in Futurity award will be divided: 50% to the recorded breeder of the winner and 50% to the recorded owner of the winner. The 5% awarded to the Best Junior and Best Senior in Futurity is to be divided: 50% to the recorded breeder, 30% to the recorded owner and 20% to the owner of the sire or owner of the frozen semen at the time of mating, for each winner.

The remaining 65 percent of the total purse shall be divided according to the percent of the total entry represented by the number of dogs entered in each class.

Monetary Awards will be given to the handler presenting the puppy in the ring for the four class placements. The Best Junior, Best Senior and Best in Futurity monetary awards will be given to the breeder who nominated the litter, the sire's owner who is listed first on the litter nomination and the puppy owner who is listed first on the individual puppy nomination. The monetary award will be mailed to them should they not be present. Monetary awards, which are provided for but cannot be given, whatever the reason, shall be applied to the total Futurity Stake for the following year.
