VETERAN DOGS I VETERAN BITCHES I

A class for Dogs and a class for Bitches seven years and under ten years.

VETERAN DOGS II VETERAN BITCHES II

A class for Dogs and a class for Bitches ten years of age and older.

Dogs/Bitches entered in Veterans Class need not be intact. Spayed and Neutered animals are eligible.

GUN DOG-DOG CLASS GUN DOG-BITCH CLASS

Open to any dog or bitch with an AKC Hunt Test title.

FIELD TRIAL DOG CLASS FIELD TRIAL BITCH CLASS

Open to any dog or bitch with an AKC field trial placement.

Winners of the above non-regular classes, if undefeated,
are eligible to compete for Best of Breed

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owners' records.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving multiple dog entries)

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and two or more of their get. Entry Fee: \$25.00 if dog is not entered in another class at this event, or \$12 as an additional entry. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: For Brood Bitches and two or more of their Produce. Entry Fee: \$25.00 if dog is not entered in another class at this event, or \$12 as an additional entry. Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class. *NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.*

BRACE CLASS: Two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The Dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. Entry fee \$25 for Unit if either dog is not entered in another class at this event, or \$12 for Unit as an additional entry. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars MUST be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by same owner, dogs comprising EACH BRACE must be designated "Brace No. 1," Brace No. 2," etc.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION – EACH DAY

NOVICE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. **NOVICE CLASS DIVIDED:** **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

OPEN CLASS: For Boys and Girls who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. **OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:** **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 816-3776. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

Heading North on I-5: Take the Sunset/Mt. Baker Hwy. Exit (#255) turn right at the end of the off ramp. Not counting the lights at the end of the off ramp, go to the third intersection and turn left onto Hannegan Rd. Drive around the corner, down the hill and approximately 7.5 miles to Hemmi Rd., you will pass through, Bakerview, Smith (lighted intersection) then Axton Rd. The road after Axton is Laurel, the very next road is Hemmi. You will see a "Fish market" on your left immediately before Hemmi Rd. Turn right onto Hemmi (there are turn lanes). Go 3/10 of a mile past the school driveway, you will see the dog agility equipment in the field, a gold mail box and a reflective blue house number sign, 1012 E. Hemmi on the left, take the driveway between the agility field and the mail box. Continue past the two houses (ours) and turn left into the parking lot at the Hy-Line Hotel & Training 4 Dogs sign. Please DO NOT park between the two houses.

Heading South on I-5: Take the Ferndale Main St. exit, turn left and go back over I-5, you will be on Axton Rd. Continue on Axton to Guide Meridian (lighted intersection), turn left onto Guide Meridian. The next signal lighted intersection is Laurel, continue through Laurel and the next road is Hemmi Rd., there is a yellow road name sign on your right but it's tough to see the actual road until you are right on top of it. Turn right onto Hemmi Rd. continue 2.1 miles to Hannegan, go through Hannegan then 3/10 of a mile, past the school entrance, you will see the dog agility equipment in the field, a gold mail box and a reflective blue house number sign, 1012 E. Hemmi on the left, take the driveway between the agility field and the mail box. Continue past the two houses (ours) and turn left into the parking lot at the Hy-Line Hotel & Training 4 Dogs sign. Please DO NOT park between the two houses.

CANOPIES FOR SHADE ARE ALLOWED

Per AKC rules, they must be positioned 10 feet back from any ring.
A clear walkway will be maintained around the rings.

SWEEPSTAKES – FRIDAY ONLY

Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. All dogs and bitches entered in Sweepstakes MUST ALSO be entered in a Regular Class at this Specialty, at the regular entry fee. The Sweepstakes is open to all dogs/bitches who are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. Champions of Record at the time that entries close are eligible for the Sweepstakes. Professional handlers may only show dogs they own, co-own or have bred. Entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as the regular classes, indicating in the space for “Additional Classes” your entry in Sweepstakes.

SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATION

DISTRIBUTION OF SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

35% to be retained by Club for expenses. The remaining 65% of the total Sweepstakes entry fee income is known as the Sweepstakes Fund and will be divided among the winners in each class as follows: First Place - 40% of entry fee in that class. Second Place - 30% of entry fee in that class. Third Place - 20% of entry fee in that class. Fourth Place - 10% of entry fee in that class.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES – FRIDAY ONLY

Veteran Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. Dogs and bitches entered in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in any other class at this Specialty. Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all dogs/bitches who are at least 7 years of age on the day of the show. Champions of Record at the time that entries close are eligible for the Sweepstakes. Professional handlers may only show dogs they own, co-own or have bred. Entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as any other classes entered, indicating your entry in Veteran Sweepstakes.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATION

- The AKC will collect a \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee and a 50 cent Recording Fee for the first entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for the AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Event/Recording Fees to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.00 shall be required for each entry of each dog. (Rally Regulations, Ch. 1, Sec. 3).
- CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or its Superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. The Superintendent will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made.
- ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify the Superintendent at (360) 683-1507 or email dogshows@dbamlg.com
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per event. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge of \$20.00 will be added. FAX NUMBER: (360) 683-6654. This is for Fax Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). - RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Superintendent will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP SUBSTITUTION OF DOG. There will be an Administrative Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show.
- The judging will start promptly. Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their time of judging, and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for this show will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.
- TROPHIES & PRIZES will be awarded in the ring to the person exhibiting the dog. No awards will be mailed.
- ALL RIGHTS TO TELEVISION, VIDEOTAPE, ADVERTISE, PHOTOGRAPH, PROMOTE or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons and animals on the Show Grounds at any time while the show is in progress, do by attending this show or participating therein, grant to the Club the right to photograph, televise, videotape, audiotape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent. The Club is not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this show.
