There are three options for grooming space at the 2019 National – grooming space is limited.

Once sold out, options will disappear from the list below on our website. So if the type of space you're looking for isn't shown, they're all gone. Hurry and make your reservation while you can! Absolutely NO grooming is permitted in the Grand Ballroom except in reserved ringside grooming area, where no hair dryers are permitted.

1. Reserved Grooming with Power will be available. Grooming space is 5' x 6'.

This is adjacent to the ballroom where exhibiting will take place, but is limited. Sorry, requests to be located next to another exhibitor cannot be managed, limit one space per registration.

2. Ring-Side Reserved Grooming will be available. Grooming space is 4' x 4'. We are excited to offer ringside grooming so that the exhibitor can watch the show as they wait for their class. It is only to be used for running a brush through your dog not for heavy duty grooming, trimming feet etc. You must not leave any dogs unattended on tables or crates. If a dog is being noisy we may ask you to take the dog to the regular grooming areas so that everyone can enjoy the show without noise in the main ballroom. Sorry, requests to be located next to another exhibitor cannot be managed, limit one space per registration.

3. Non-Reserved Grooming is limited and available on a first-come-first-served basis. Power is not available in this area, and running extension cords from the reserved grooming area is not allowed.

Winners of above classes, if otherwise undefeated, will compete for:

WINNERS DOG WINNERS BITCH
BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. Select Dog and Select Bitch, where applicable, will be chosen immediately following Best of Breed competition. This will be followed by Best Owner-Handled.

Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided the criteria set forth in Chapter 16, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows is met.

NON REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE ENTRIES

Because WINNERS of these classes will compete for Best of Breed, all entrants MUST also meet ALL American Kennel Club requirements for Non-Regular Classes involving single dog entries. The following classes are divided by sex.

VETERAN 7-10 YRS DOGS	VETERAN 7-10 YRS BITCHES
VETERAN 10 YRS & OVER DOGS	VETERAN 10 YRS & OVER BITCHES

Veteran 7-10 yrs: Class for dogs and class for bitches 7 years old and under 10 years.

Veteran 10 yrs & over: Class for dogs and class for bitches 10 years old and over.

VETERANS NOTE: If a dog is entered in both Veteran Class and Best of Breed and is defeated in Veterans, the dog can NOT be shown in Best of Breed. Veteran class entrants at an independent specialty may be altered.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING MULTIPLE ENTRIES - NATIONAL ONLY

As the judge's decision in the following classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won in these classes.

STUD DOG: Class for Stud Dogs and no less than two and no more than four of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Entry only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the Standard for its breed. Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes or Best of Breed Competition. Notation must be made on entry form.

BROOD BITCH: Same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog & Produce for Get.

BRACE: The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog, which is part of a Brace, is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc.

JUMP HEIGHT MUST BE INDICATED ON ALL APPLICABLE OBEDIENCE & RALLY CLASSES

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.
