The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES *(Involving Single Dog Entries)*

VETERAN DOGS 6 years and under 8 years	VETERAN BITCHES 6 years and under 8 years
VETERAN DOGS, 8 years and under 10 years	VETERAN BITCHES, 8 years and under 10 years
VETERAN DOGS, 10 years and older	VETERAN BITCHES, 10 years and older

Dogs/Bitches entered in Veterans need not be intact. Spayed and Neutered animals are eligible.

Winners of the above Non-Regular Classes, if otherwise undefeated, compete for Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES *(Involving Multiple Dog Entries)*

Note - As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Get must be entered individually in one of the Regular Classes or Best of Breed.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: Same as Stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

*Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class".

BRACE CLASS: For two dogs with at least one common owner and presented in the ring with no more than one handler. Both dogs must be entered in another class at this specialty show. The entry fee is \$10.50 as an additional entry for the Brace, per Dog. The entry form for each dog entered as a part of a brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space for Additional Classes - "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc.

SPECIAL COMPETITIONS

BEST BRINDLE: After Best of Breed, Selects and Awards of Merit are chosen, the qualifying brindle dogs/bitches compete for Best Brindle. This is competition is *open to any brindle competing in Regular Classes, not defeated by another brindle. Open to Highest Placing Brindle in each class. If no placing brindles in class, then all brindles in class are then eligible.*

BEST PUPPY FROM THE REGULAR CLASSES: After Best of Breed, Selects and Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of regular puppy classes compete for Best Puppy from the Regular Classes. If Best of Winners is from the regular puppy classes, that entry is automatically Best Puppy from the Regular Classes.

BEST VETERAN: After Best of Breed, Selects and Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of the veteran classes compete for Best Veteran. If Best of Breed is from a veteran's class, that entry is automatically Best Veteran.

BEST FROM THE BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASSES: After Best of Breed, Selects and Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of Bred By Exhibitor Dog and Bred By Exhibitor Bitch compete for Best Bred by Exhibitor. If Best of Winners is from the Bred by Exhibitor class, that entry is automatically Best Bred by Exhibitor.

NOTE: Best Veteran, Best Brindle or Best Puppy competition will be forgone if the Best of Breed is one or more of the above.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show..

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

AWARDS OF MERIT: The judge may, at his/her discretion, recall into the ring up to five (5) Bullmastiffs (including Best of Breed & Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed) to receive a ornate silver ornament with inlay of award. These ornate silver ornaments are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The purpose of the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner-Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.

- Dog must be marked as eligible to compete in the AKC NOHS prior to the closing of entries. There is no additional fee to enter this competition.
- Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition.
- Exhibitors must declare their dog AKC National Owner-Handled Series eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show. Dogs declared eligible will be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the judge's book, steward's book, and the show catalog.
- *Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit.
- The Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition.
- *Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household. Household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household.

SWEEPSTAKES: Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes and is open to all Bullmastiffs who on the day of the show, will be 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. Classes will be divided by age and sex. All entries in the sweepstakes MUST also be entered in a Regular Class or for Best of Breed at this show. Entries shall be made at the same time and on the same entry forms as for the Regular Classes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and the age division in the space provided for "Additional Classes." Each dog entered must be handled by the owner, by a member of the owner's immediate family, or by an amateur handler with exception that professional handlers may handle only dogs that they own/co-own or are the breeder/co-breeder of record and handle without recompense. All prize money is the property of the owner.

Entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes may be shown by anyone in good standing with the American Kennel Club.

RV PARKING / TENT CAMPING GUIDELINES

The Event Center does not have a campground. We offer designated spots as a convenience to show participants. These spots may have electric, but there are no hook-ups. Following are the guidelines for RV and tent camping on the grounds. Please ensure you are aware of all policies.

1. RV parking and tent camping is only available to show participants and vendors, and may not be available for all events.
2. Unless an event is ongoing, Event Center gates are locked at 5:00pm each night. Emergency exit is available through the Maintenance Plaza and Loading Dock gates. These gates are automatic and are activated by driving your vehicle over the area right in front of the gate. Once you leave the property, re-entry may not be available. Please ensure you can re-enter before leaving the property.
3. Only registered RVs/Tent Campers may park in designated spaces. Supply trailers must be disconnected from RV or livestock trailer and parked in the designated area(s).
4. Due to limited space on the grounds, it may be necessary to park support vehicles in the exterior lots or away from the RV sites.
5. The Event Manager has the authority to designate the location of each RV/Tent Camping spot, as well as have vehicles towed, and if necessary, request the removal of disruptive campers, or campers that are not following the guidelines set forth in this document.
6. No RVs or camping vehicles may be plugged into outlets inside buildings without prior FSMG approval.
7. Do not remove temp fencing or access any building other than those rented for the event you are participating in.
8. Do not drive across or park in any grass areas without prior FSMG approval.
9. Absolutely **NO alcohol is permitted outside of RVs/Tents**. Any alcohol consumption outside of RVs/Tents may lead to being trespassed from the Fairgrounds.
10. **NO open flame fires are permitted on the grounds.**
11. **Absolutely NO dumping of gray water or sewage on the grounds.**
