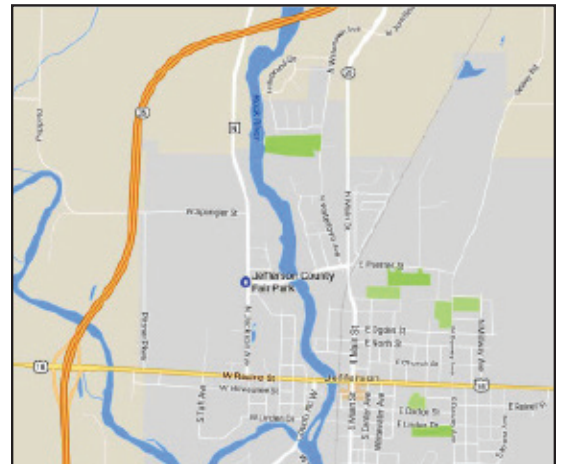
ROUTES TO SHOW

FROM (IOWA & SOUTHWEST WISCONSIN)-US 12 East/US 18 East to US 18 East. Turn **Left** on US 18 East. US 18 East to N Jackson Ave. Turn **Left** on N Jackson Ave.

FROM SOUTH (INTERSTATE 1-90/I-39)-Hwy 26 North to new Hwy 26 Bypass. Take Exit Hwy 18 (Cambridge/Jefferson Exit). Turn **Right** on Hwy 18. Turn **Left** on N Jackson Ave.

FROM WEST/EAST (INTERSTATE I-94)-I-94 West to Exit 267 (Hwy 26/Johnson Creek/Watertown Exit) Turn **Left** on Hwy 26 South to new Hwy 26 Bypass. Take Exit Business Hwy 26. Turn **Left** on Business Hwy 26. Take **Right** on W Puerner Street.

Any other vehicle plugged into electricity at any time will be charged the daily rate of \$40.00.

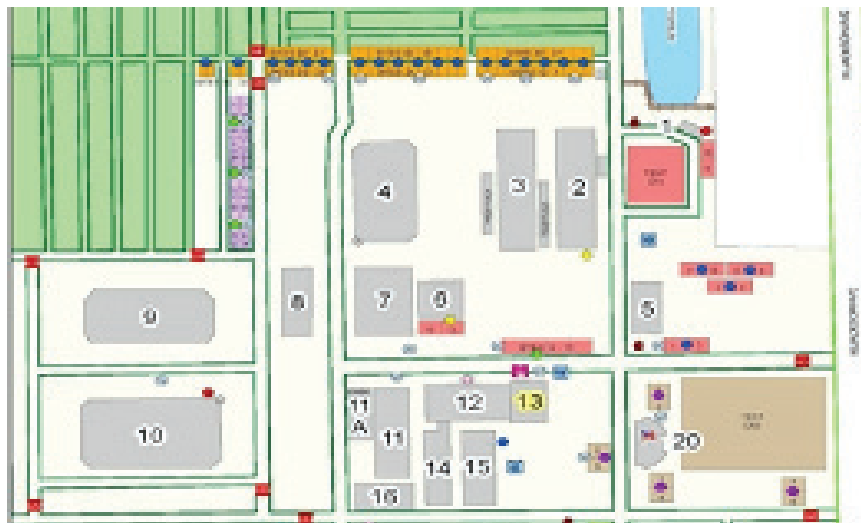

FAIRGROUND LAYOUT

SHOW RINGS will be in buildings 2 (dairy barn), 3 (horse barn) and 5 (cleary building). **Vendors and groups** will be in building 2. **SPECIALTIES/SUPPORTED ENTRIES** will be in building 12 (activities center). **SPECIALTY CLUB ACTIVITIES** will be in building 14 (west building) unless it is needed for rings and then they would be moved into building 15 (east building). Overflow rings will be set up if needed in buildings 8 (draft horse barn), 6 (warm-up arena/dirt floor), 7 (indoor horse arena/dirt floor) and 16 (sale arena).

1. The shows will be closed to the general public. Please have proof of entry (email confirmation, id card, etc) available upon arrival to the site. You will receive a wristband to be worn during our show weekend. Anyone attending the shows with an owner, exhibitor, handler, handler assistant, judge, club members, any hired professionals (photo, video, superintendents, stewards, etc.) will be registered for contact tracing and given a wristband.
 2. Masks are required and masks must cover your mouth and nose at all times unless stated below. ***If you do NOT follow this rule, you will be asked to leave and receive no refund.*** Judges will have authority to ask exhibitors to leave if they feel rules are not being followed.
 - a. Buildings: When inside any building under WI Guidelines – Masks are required at all times, including in the rings. You may raise or lower your mask to get a drink or wipe sweat away but must maintain social distancing. You must keep your mask on when gaiting your dog in the ring, NO EXCEPTIONS.
 - b. Vendor Booths – Masks must be worn at all times when in a vendor's booth. NO EXCEPTIONS.
 - c. Outdoors – Under WI guidelines mask are required 100% of the time when in public areas. Under the new guideline masks must be worn at all times while at the shows REGARDLESS if you can or cannot social distance. Mask do not need to be worn in your vehicle space area as long as you are able to social distance (6'). You do not need to wear masks if the people round you are staying with you.
 3. Additional rings may be put up and spread around the fairgrounds in order to allow social distancing including in buildings with dirt floors or outdoors. Please be aware of where your rings may be. There is no withdrawal of entry if your ring location is changed. Groups may be judged outdoors.
 4. Judges may also change to handle the overflow.
 5. All rings will have a separate entrance and exit. 6 feet will be marked from the ring for social distancing.
 6. Buildings will also have a separate entrance and exit where possible. Please follow signs to avoid roadblocks.
 7. Doors to the barns will be kept open. Please dress appropriately.
 8. Please keep aisles as clear as possible and no socializing at ring areas.
 9. Hand sanitizer stations will be at all entrances and we will try to have them ringside.
 10. Armbands will be at separate tables based on groups. No armbands will be given out ringside.
 11. No public catalogs. Show catalogs will be for sale.
 12. No public chairs will be provided.
 13. Please respect all club members and superintendents and social distance and do not take off your mask. Many are in High Risk categories and are working the shows for you, so respect them and don't put them at any additional risk.
 14. When a club member/volunteer asks you to do something, please realize that they are doing this to follow regulations and do NOT take out any irritations on them. We will not hesitate to ask you to leave if we feel you are being abusive.
 15. As of now, we are limited to 50 (fifty) people or less in any venue at one time. Only the person showing the dog will be admitted into the building. Because of this, we are encouraging "show and go." If we see people loitering, we may ask you to leave the building to keep our count in range.
 16. Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact.
 17. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
 18. Avoid common use pens/pencils – bring your own writing instruments.
 19. Exhibitors must provide their own means for cleaning up from their dogs in public Ex-Pens & the entire facility. There will be NO public scoops.
 20. Prepare to be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, bring personal use masks, shade for your dog/s. There will be hand sanitizing stations and we will have extra masks in case someone needs one.
 21. Do not crowd the Superintendent's table. Wait 6' behind the person in front of you.
 22. When at vendors of food concessions please maintain 6' social distancing in line.
 23. All Club members, volunteers, judges and exhibitors are required to self-assess each morning prior to attending that day's show.

Please have this completed prior to arriving to avoid delays at the gate!!!

I fully attest to the best of my knowledge I do not have COVID-19 at the time of attending this event. I, also, attest I have NOT been in contact with or exposed to any known carrier of COVID-19 within the past 14 days. I agree that I am attending the Rock River Classic Dog Shows entirely at my own risk and take full responsibility for my own health and safety during this event. I will follow all AKC, Club & Fairground requirements, procedures, protocols and guidelines to reduce any exposure and possibility of contracting or spreading the virus. I will also follow CDC, Federal, State of Wisconsin, Jefferson County, City of Jefferson guidelines with respect to COVID-19.
