

## Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, including FSS breeds, or are registerable breeds that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

### Course Familiarization and Warm Ups

There will be no obstacle familiarization at this trial. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump shall be provided for all exhibitors.

### Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in the Trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher jump height class.

## Notice to Exhibitors

Judges will be available before each class for measuring dogs that did not present a height card and for those without height cards.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all obstacles safely.

**Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.**

Puppies under the age of 6 months are strictly prohibited from the site.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee. The fees will be refunded for entries withdrawn at least 48 hours prior to the Trial and for bitches in season or injured dogs prior to the date of the Trial. No refunds for duplicate entries.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or in the designated agility warm up area. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of regulations for agility Trials.

Make check and money order payable to ARC 2008 Nationals (American Rottweiler Club). Canadian exhibitors make fees payable in US \$. All entries and fees are to be sent to the trial secretary, Karl Johnson, 1968 95<sup>th</sup> Ave SE, St. Cloud, MN 56304-9758. There is a limit of entries included in any single envelope/entry transaction of ten (10) dogs.


