

– NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS –

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The AKC will collect a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on each entry of a dog, and 50 cent Recording Fee for the first entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule. Ch. 11, Sec. 2). In accordance with AKC Rally regulations, the AKC will collect a \$3.00 per entry of dog Rally Event Service Fee. A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for AKC.
- CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club, The Show Secretary and/or BaRay Events assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

- ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify the BaRay Events at (360) 683-1507 or email [dogshows@barayevents.com](mailto:dogshows@barayevents.com).
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. BaRay Events will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs entered for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.

#### ***Bred by Exhibitor Class Eligibility – Effective September 2002***

- All dogs entered in the Bred By Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with AKC.
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

#### **Non-Regular Classes (Involving Single Dog Entries)**

***Winners of these classes, if otherwise undefeated, will compete for Best of Breed.***

*A Class for Dog and a Class for Bitches 7 years of age and older.*

*Dogs/bitches entered in Veterans need not be intact. Spayed and Neutered animals are eligible.*

FIELD TRIAL DOGS    FIELD TRIAL BITCHES

*For those Dogs and Bitches who have a placement in the Senior Stakes*

*(example, Gun Dog or All Age) or a first in Derby Stakes at an AKC Licensed Field Trial.*

HUNTING DOG DOGS    HUNTING DOG BITCHES

*For those Dogs and Bitches who have achieved the G.S.C.A. WDWR Title*

*or the AKC Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter, Master Hunter Titles.*

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

#### **Non-Regular Classes (involving multiple dog entries)**

**STUD DOG CLASS:** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its Breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class.

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**BROOD BITCH CLASS:** For Brood Bitches and two of their produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its Breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class.

**BRACE CLASS:** For two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be designated "Brace No.1," "Brace No.2"

### **OBEDIENCE TRIAL CLASSES**

*Qualifying score is required for all prizes in the regular classes.*

*There shall be a refund of all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches, entered in obedience, who come in season after the closing date of the obedience trial. To be eligible for the refund, a certificate from a veterinarian must be presented to the obedience chair before judging begins.*

### **RALLY TRIAL CLASSES**

Rally is the sport in which the dog and handler complete a course that has been designed by the rally judge. Dogs competing in Rally Novice A, Advanced A or Excellent A classes may not have attained an AKC Rally Novice A or Obedience CD, CDX or UD. Dogs must be handled by the owner or member of the owner's household, or immediate family. The following Rally Trial Classes will be offered:

Rally Novice A • Rally Advanced A • Rally Excellent A

Rally Novice B • Rally Advanced B • Rally Excellent B

### **SWEEPSTAKES**

This Sweepstakes is open to all Gordon Setters who, on the day of the show, will be at least six months and under 18 months of age. Sweepstakes Classes will be judged prior to the regular breed classes. Winners of the Sweepstakes Classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes. Entry fee is \$20.00. All entrants in Sweepstakes must also be entered in a regular class at this show at the regular class entry fee. Entries shall be made at the same time on the same form as for the regular class. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and the appropriate age and sex in the space provided for "Additional Classes." *NOTE: Dogs or Bitches between the ages of 12 and 18 months are not puppies and the regular entry fee applies in the Regular Classes.*
