## – NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS –

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The AKC will collect a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on each entry of a dog, and 50 cent Recording Fee for the first entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule. Ch.11, Sec. 2). In accordance with AKC Rally regulations, the AKC will collect a \$3.00 per entry of dog Rally Event Service Fee. A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for AKC.
- CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club, Show Secretary and/or BaRay Events assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. - ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify the BaRay Events at (360) 683-1507 or email [dogshows@barayevents.com](mailto:dogshows@barayevents.com).
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. BaRay Events will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. - No FLEXI-LEADS allowed on dogs in Show/Trial area.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. **BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

**BEST PUPPY FROM THE REGULAR PUPPY CLASSES:** To be selected from the first place winners in the Puppy Classes (6-9 mos. & 9-12 mos.)

**BEST VETERAN FROM THE VETERANS CLASSES:** To be selected from the first place winners of all the Veteran Classes.

**JUDGE'S AWARD OF MERIT:** The Judge may select up to 4 Tollers of the superior quality specimens in addition to Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex from the intersex competition.

**BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR COMPETITION:** To be selected from the first place winners of the Bred-By-Exhibitor Classes.

**BEST HUNTING RETRIEVER COMPETITION:** To be selected from the first place winners of all the Hunting Retriever Classes.

#### **Non-Regular Classes (Involving multiple Dog Entries)**

**STUD DOG CLASS:** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed, or some other non-regular class.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS:** For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be the owner of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed, or some other non-regular class.

**BRACE CLASS:** For two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be designated "Brace No.1," "Brace No.2"

*NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Class is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in this class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.*

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS REGARDING CORRECTIONS OR CHANGES TO ENTRIES:** Corrections other than the specific changes listed in Ch. 11, Sec. 6 (i.e. sex of a dog, transfers between age specific classes, and “move-up’s” to BOB or BOV) are the only changes to the entries superintendents or secretaries are authorized to make after closing of entries. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. **THIS RULE IS BEING STRICTLY ENFORCED BY THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB. PLEASE CHECK YOUR ENTRIES CAREFULLY.** Corrections to entries may be made by the Superintendent prior to the closing of entries if such correction is submitted in writing. Exhibitors are required to report any changes/corrections after closing directly to the American Kennel Club.

### ENTRIES, CANCELLATIONS, CHANGES, TRANSFERS

Entries must be accompanied by a cover sheet stating the number of pages, what shows and how many dogs per show. Visa, MasterCard, and American Express are accepted for Fax entries. Credit card information (Credit Card number, expiration date, and cardholder name) must be on cover sheet. ## **SWEEPSTAKES**

A Sweepstakes will be held in conjunction with this Specialty. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. All dogs and bitches entered in Sweepstakes MUST ALSO be entered in a Regular Class at this Specialty, at the regular entry fee. The Sweepstakes is open to all dogs/bitches who are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. Champions of Record at the time that entries close are not eligible for the Sweepstakes. Entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as the regular classes, indicating in the space for "Additional Classes" your entry in Sweepstakes. HANDLER: The handler of a Sweepstakes exhibit must be either the owner, co-owner, breeder or a member of their immediate family as defined by the AKC as of the closing date for the show for which the Sweepstakes entry is being made.

## **VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES**

A Veteran Sweepstakes will be held in conjunction with this Specialty. Veteran Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. Dogs and bitches entered in Veteran Sweepstakes NEED NOT be entered in a Regular Class at this Specialty. The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all dogs/bitches who are at least 7 years of age on the day of the show. Entrants need not be intact. Spayed or Neutered animals are eligible. Entries must be made on the same entry form, indicating your entry in Veteran Sweepstakes.

### **VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATION**

Classes are divided by age and sex as follows:

Dogs (7 yrs. & under 10 yrs.)	Bitches (7 yrs. & under 10 yrs.)
Dogs (10 yrs. & Older)	Bitches (10 yrs. & older).

**NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:** **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 816-3776. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

## **CHALLENGE TROPHIES**

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**Best Puppy Perpetual Trophy:** This is a bronze sculpture of a retriever playing in the water. Sagewood Kennel Best Puppy in Specialty Show Trophy offered by Patty and Paul Beran through the Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever Club (USA). This trophy is offered on a three-time win basis, with permanent possession of the trophy going to any person/owner who wins the trophy three separate times, not necessarily with the same dog.

**Best Veteran Perpetual Trophy:** This is an etched crystal of a toller coming out of the water with a duck. Hoch Memorial Trophy offered by Dee Nichols (KD's Kennel) and Laura White (Cinnstar Kennels) in memory of Robert Hoch through the NSDTRC (USA). This trophy is offered on a three-time win basis, with permanent possession of the trophy going to any person/owner who wins the trophy three separate times, not necessarily with the same dog

**High in Trial Perpetual Trophy:** A silver cup trophy on a base. Lonetree Kennel High in Trial Trophy offered by Lonetree Kennels through the NSDTRC (USA).
