– NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS –

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- A RECORDING FEE will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).
- CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Event Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or its Show Event Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. The Event Secretary will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Event Secretary will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Only dogs eligible for this show will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- The judging will start promptly. Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their time of judging, and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.
- ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify the Event Secretary at (360)683-1507 or email dogshows@dbamlg.com
- TROPHIES will be awarded to the person exhibiting the dog in the ring. None will be mailed.

NOTE – NEW BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY

- All dogs entered in the Bred By Exhibitor Class must be **individually registered** with the AKC. •
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog AND an owner of record of the dog. •
- To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder AND owner of record. •

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (Involving Single Dog Entries)

VETERAN DOGS VETERAN BITCHES

(For Dogs & Bitches 7 Years of Age and Older)

Neutered Dogs & Spayed Bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes

Note: Winners of both Veteran Classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

BEST PUPPY IN THE PUPPY CLASSES (OESCA ONLY)

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and two of their get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS (OESCA ONLY): Two dogs of identical ownership. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars MUST be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes. "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by same owner, dogs comprising EACH BRACE must be so designated – "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.

TEAM CLASS (OESCA ONLY): Four dogs of identical ownership. The dogs comprising a Team MUST be named at the time of entry. In making entries for "Team Class Only" full particulars MUST be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Team MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes. "Team Class." If more than one Team is entered by same owner, dogs comprising EACH TEAM must be so designated – "Team No. 1," "Team No. 2," etc.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace and Team Classes is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC 919-854-0195.

Novice Junior. This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 10 years old and under 14 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior. This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 14 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior. This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 10 years old and under 14 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present.
