

### SECURITY NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

Allow PLENTY OF TIME to get to your rings because of the ADDITIONAL SECURITY required by the Seahawks Exhibition Center. Judges will not wait for you to get to the ring. Visible Identification will be provided with your acknowledgement (two per dog). Because of heightened security, you MUST wear this identification at all times while on facility property. All bags, purses, crates, grooming boxes, etc. will be checked at the doors.

**NO TAPE WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE FLOORS EXCEPT AS PROVIDED BY S.K.C.**

### USE OF RAMPS

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Petits Bassets Griffons Vendeens, Whippets, Staffordshire Bull Terriers & Bulldogs. Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In an emergency situation, an exhibitor does have the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

#### NOTE – NEW BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY

- All dogs entered in the Bred By Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. •
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog AND an owner of record of the dog. •
- To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder AND owner of record. •

#### Non-Regular Classes (Involving Single Dog Entries)

VETERAN DOGS CLASS    VETERAN BITCHES CLASS

A Class for Dogs and a Class for Bitches 7 Years of Age and Older

NOTE: Dogs/Bitches entered in Veterans Class must be intact. Spayed and Neutered animals are not eligible. All Dogs/Bitches who win Best of Breed/Variety from the Veterans Class are eligible to compete in their respective Group.

#### BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If at the end of the 90 day period the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC."

**Retrievers (Labrador):** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black; Chocolate; Yellow.

**Dachshunds (Longhaired):** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Miniature (under 11 lbs. & 12 mos. old or over); Standard (11 lbs. & over and under 11 lbs. if less than 12 mos. old).

**Dachshunds (Smooth):** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Miniature (under 11 lbs. & 12 mos. old or over); Standard (11 lbs. & over and under 11 lbs. if less than 12 mos. old). Open Standard Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black & Tan including any other color except Red; Red.

**Dachshunds (Wirehaired):** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Miniature (under 11 lbs. & 12 mos. old or over); Standard (11 lbs. & over and under 11 lbs. if less than 12 mos. old).

**Boxers:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Brindle; Fawn.

**Bullmastiffs:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Brindle; Any Other Allowed Color.

**Doberman Pinschers:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black; Any Other Allowed Color.

**Great Danes:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black; Blue; Brindle; Fawn; Harlequin; Mantle.

**St Bernards:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Longhaired; Shorthaired.

**Pugs:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black; Fawn.

**Chinese Shar-Pei:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Brush Coat; Horse Coat.

**Australian Shepherds:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black; Blue Merle; Red Merle; Red.

**Collies (Rough):** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Blue Merle; Sable & White; Tri-Color; White.

**Shetland Sheepdogs:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Sable & White; Any Other Allowed Color.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION – EACH DAY

**NOVICE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. **NOVICE CLASS DIVIDED: Junior**-10 years old and under 14 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-14 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

**OPEN CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. **OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: Junior**-10 years old and under 14 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-14 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

## SHOW INFORMATION

- The show site will be available to exhibitors 3PM to 10PM Friday, Jan. 30, 2004. Doors are locked at 10PM. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging Sunday, February 1, 2004.
- Each entry will receive two (2) Identification/Admission Wristbands per dog entered with their acknowledgement. Wristbands are good for each day that dog is entered. To gain admittance for each day into the show building, each person MUST wear their ID or pay admission. Absolutely NO EXCEPTIONS.
- No exercise pens will be permitted after 8AM each day except in reserved grooming area.
- All dogs shall be kept on leash except when in the obedience or agility ring.
- There shall be no drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the grounds or premises.
- STOOP TO SCOOP. Remember the Seattle City "Poop Scoop" Law – \$500 FINE for anyone seen leaving their dog's excrement on city property. Designated exercise areas will be clearly marked.
- No baby strollers or wheeled child carriers allowed in the building.

– NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS –

- Dogs must be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs need to be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or its Superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. **RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.**
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES** or **OVERPAYMENTS**. The Superintendent will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show **NO REFUND** will be made.
- **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE.** The Superintendent will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY BASIS**.
