

**– NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS**

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- Effective for all events held on and after January 1, 2008, The American Kennel Club will collect a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. The current 50 cent recording fee will continue to be collected where applicable. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for The American Kennel Club. These event service and recording fees shall be forwarded to The American Kennel Club along with all other required event results within seven (7) days of the close of the event.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. **RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.**
- **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE.** BaRay Events will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- **REFUNDS** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent **AFTER THE SHOW.** An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries. There is no refund for bitches in season in Obedience.
- **FAX ENTRIES** – Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge of \$20.00 will be added. **FAX NUMBER:** (360) 683-6654. This is for Fax Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). - **ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED** after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify BaRay Events at (360) 683-1507 or email [dogshows@barayevents.com](mailto:dogshows@barayevents.com).
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES** or **OVERPAYMENTS**. BaRay Events will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show **NO REFUND** will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent/Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- **LOSS OR DAMAGE** – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- **ALL RIGHTS TO TELEVISION, VIDEOTAPE, ADVERTISE, PHOTOGRAPH, PROMOTE** or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. **EXHIBITOR RULE CHANGE EFFECTIVE 01/01/2010**

---

Chapter 11, Section 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. *For complete details see Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 1.*

### **BREEDS WITH OPEN CLASS DIVISIONS AT THESE SHOWS**

#### **OPEN CLASS DIVISION *MUST* BE INDICATED ON ENTRY BLANK**

**Retrievers (Labrador):** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black; Chocolate; Yellow.

**Dachshunds (Longhaired):** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Miniature (under 11 lbs. & 12 mos. old or over); Standard (11 lbs. & over and under 11 lbs. If less than 12 mos. old).

**Dachshunds (Smooth):** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Miniature (under 11 lbs. & 12 mos. old or over); Standard (11 lbs. & over and under 11 lbs. if less than 12 mos. old). Open Standard Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black & Tan including any other color except Red; Red.

**Dachshunds (Wirehaired):** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Miniature (under 11 lbs. & 12 mos. old or over); Standard (11 lbs. & over and under 11 lbs. if less than 12 mos. old).

**Boxers:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Brindle; Fawn.

**Bullmastiffs:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Brindle; Any Other Allowed Color.

**Doberman Pinschers:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black; Any Other Allowed Color.

**Great Danes:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black, Blue, Brindle, Fawn, Harlequin, Mantle.

**St. Bernards:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Longhaired; Shorthaired.

**Pekingese:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Under 8 lbs. and 12 months old or over; 8 lbs. and Over and under 8 lbs, if less than 12 months old.

**Pugs:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black, Fawn.

**Boston Terriers:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Under 15 pounds; 15 pounds and under 20 pounds; 20 pounds and not to exceed 25 pounds.

**Chinese Shar-Pei:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Brush Coat; Horse Coat.

**Chow Chows:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black, Red, Any Other Color.

**Australian Shepherds:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black; Blue Merle; Red; Red Merle.

**Collies (Rough):** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Blue Merle; Sable & White; Tri-Color; White.

**Shetland Sheepdogs:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Sable & White; Any Other Allowed Color.

**ATTENTION – SHOW GROUND RULES**

- **Gray water cannot be dumped or dripped on the ground. The appropriate sewer hookup or dump station should be used for depositing all gray (and black) water. Security will enforce the “no dumping” rule. There is a \$500.00 fine for all/any infractions of this policy.**
- An EMT will be on Show Grounds Each Day
- **THE GROUNDS WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR SET-UP OF GROOMING EQUIPMENT FROM 12:00 Noon until 4:00 PM on the day prior to the Shows.**
- **CONTROL OF THE GROOMING AND CRATING AREAS WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE GROUNDS CHAIRMAN.** No roping off or saving of grooming areas. Show Committee reserves the right to rearrange crates etc., in the non-reserved grooming area in order to make more room. Grooming equipment left in day grooming area after Best in Show will be confiscated.
- Grooming and Crating area aisles must remain open at all times.
- No Grooming or exercise pens, Cocker pens, Toy pens or canopies are allowed in the Show Building. Crates are only allowed in the show building during showing of your breed and must be removed immediately after. Violators will be fined \$25.00 per occurrence.
- Grounds will be open at 6:00 AM and close two (2) hours after Best in Show each day.
- There will be no parking on the Fairgrounds. Violators will be towed at the owners’ risk and expense.
- **Loss or Damage** - The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor’s child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor/Parent. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the shows **OR THE EXHIBITOR/PARENT WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOW PREMISES.**
- The only fresh water available on the grounds will be in the restrooms. Exhibitors are responsible for the water required for the safety and comfort of their dogs. No bathing of dogs on the show grounds.
- Exhibitors and Handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their grooming area, parking area and hotel room.
- Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. X-pens will be provided outside. Exhibitors and handlers must pick up fecal matter deposited by their dogs on the grounds, streets, sidewalks and parking lots.
- **Speed limit within the Fairgrounds is 5MPH.** Anyone exceeding this speed limit will be subject to an Event Show Hearing, and/or escorted off the grounds immediately.
- **If it is necessary to rescue a dog from a parked vehicle on the show grounds or in the parking areas, the club will not be responsible or liable for any damage to the vehicle involved.** Animals left in vehicles will be monitored by County Control Officers and Club Members. If animals are in distress due to heat or any other circumstances, the vehicle will be forcibly entered, the animal recovered and the owner cited.
- **ALL ELECTRICAL DEVICES WHICH CREATE MULTIPLE OUTLETS MUST BE UL APPROVED AND INCORPORATE A SEPARATE CIRCUIT BREAKER WITHIN THE DEVICE.** All electrical cords on floor must be taped.
- These rules will be enforced by the show committee. Failure to comply with these rules will result in charges being brought before the show committee.
- No Smoking will be allowed or tolerated in any building on the Show Site. Offenders of the rule shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$50.00, and in the event of continued abuse, shall be asked to leave the show premises.
- **TROPHIES** - Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging rings to the person exhibiting the dog, who will be considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. All claims for trophies and other prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed, and the Show Chairmen advised at once in the event of any discrepancy. No Award will be mailed. The Clubs reserve the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.


