Winners of the Veteran Dog & Bitch Classes may also compete for Best of Breed Competition, provided that they are undefeated in any Regular Class at this show. ENTRY FEE \$18.00.

Field Trial Dog Class Field Trial Bitch Class

Open to any unaltered dog or bitch who has placed first, second, third or fourth in an A.K.C. Licensed or Member club Basset Hound Field Trial held by a Basset Hound Club. Name and date of trial where placements awarded must be shown on entry form. Entry fee \$18.00.

Dual Field Trial Dog Class Dual Field Trial Bitch Class

This class is open to all unaltered Dual Champion Bassets that have earned both their AKC Conformation and Field Trial Championship. Entry fee \$18.00.

Winners of the above classes, if undefeated, are eligible to compete for Best of Breed BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owners' records.

#### GRAND CHAMPION COMPETITION - (Select Dog and Select Bitch)

The following categories of dogs are entered in this competition: 1. Dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed or Best of Variety class. 2. Dogs transferred to Best of Breed/Variety which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. 3. Champions that win Non-Regular Classes and become eligible for Best of Breed competition. (Altered or spayed CH veteran class winners at independent specialties are eligible.) 4. Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition. At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to: 1. Best of Breed or Variety 2. Best of Opposite 3. Select Dog 4. Select Bitch. Grand Champion competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed competition and in breeds that are divided into varieties, Grand Champion Competition will not continue beyond Best of Variety competition.

#### Non-Regular Classes (Involving multiple dog entries)

**STUD DOG CLASS:** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Entry Fee: \$18.00 for the Unit, in addition to any regular class entry fees. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS:** For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Entry Fee: \$18.00 for the Unit, in addition to any regular class entry fee. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not

necessarily be owner of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class.

BRACE CLASS: Two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The Dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. Entry fee for Brace Class as a Unit is \$18.00. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars MUST be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by same owner, dogs comprising EACH BRACE must be designated "Brace No. 1," Brace No. 2," etc.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch or Brace Classes is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

If you build your ad 13 inches long on a LEGAL Word template, that will be acceptable and in proportion.

It is recommended that you burn a CD of any of your electronic ads and submit that to the ad chairman for your specialty. CD should be readable in both PC and MAC format.
