NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- Effective for all events held on and after January 1, 2008, The American Kennel Club will collect a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. The current 50 cent recording fee will continue to be collected where applicable. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for The American Kennel Club. These event service and recording fees shall be forwarded to The American Kennel Club along with all other required event results within seven (7) days of the close of the event.
- CANADIAN CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS MUST BE DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS, AND/OR MADE PAYABLE IN U.S. FUNDS
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. Baray Events will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries. There is no refund for bitches in season in Obedience.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge of \$20.00 will be added. FAX NUMBER: (360) 683-6654. This is for Fax Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). A Fax-Friendly entry blank PDF is available for download at www.BarayEvents.com
- ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify Baray Events at (360) 683-1507 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. Baray Events will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent/Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- TROPHIES & PRIZES will be awarded in the ring to person exhibiting the dog. No awards will be mailed.
- ALL RIGHTS TO TELEVISION, VIDEOTAPE, ADVERTISE, PHOTOGRAPH, PROMOTE or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons and animals on the Show Grounds at any time while the show is in progress, do by attending this show or participating therein, grant to the Club the right to photograph, televise, videotape, audiotape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent. The Club is not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this show.

The above Classes are provided in ALL Breeds and in each Breed Variety. Where certain classes are divided by age, color or weight it is so noted in list of breeds in this Premium List and MUST BE indicated on Entry form. Winners of above classes, if otherwise undefeated, will compete for:

WINNERS DOG WINNERS BITCH
BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If at the end of the 90 day period the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC."

SELECT DOG SELECT BITCH

GRAND CHAMPION COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs are entered in this competition:

1. Dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed or Best of Variety class.
2. Dogs transferred to Best of Breed/Variety which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed.
3. Champions that win Non-Regular Classes and become eligible for Best of Breed competition. (Altered or spayed CH veteran class winners at independent specialties are eligible.)
4. Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition.

At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to:

1. Best of Breed or Variety
2. Best of Opposite
3. Select Dog
4. Select Bitch.

Grand Champion competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed competition and in breeds that are divided into varieties, Grand Champion Competition will not continue beyond Best of Variety competition.

Obedience & Rally Classes are open to Mixed Breed Dogs at these Trials
Mixed Breeds must be registered with AKC Canine Partners Program

OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATION

Jump heights in all applicable Obedience classes will begin with 4" and run in ascending order. Please Indicate Jump Height for applicable classes on entry form.

Titling Classes

Beginner Novice: The Beginner Novice class shall be for dogs that have not won the BN title. The Beginner Novice class is an optional titling class that may be offered by clubs at obedience events. Judges for this class must be approved to judge Novice or higher classes. If eligible as defined in these regulations, dogs entered in Beginner Novice A or Beginner Novice B may also be entered in any other obedience classes.

Graduate Novice Class: For dogs that have not been certified by a judge to have received a third qualifying score toward a GD title prior to the closing of entries. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class.

Graduate Open Class: The Graduate Open Class is for dogs that have not been certified by a judge to have received a third qualifying score toward a UD title prior to the closing of entries. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class.

Non-Regular Classes

Pre-Novice Class. For dogs that have not received a third qualifying score in a Novice class prior to the closing of entries. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. All exercises will be scored as in the Novice class, except the dogs will perform all exercises on leash.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION – EACH DAY

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice class. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 816-3776. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show.

USE OF RAMPS

At the sole discretion of the judge, approved breeds may be examined on the ground or on a ramp: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Whippets, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden, and Polish Lowland Sheepdogs. Whippets may be examined on the ground, on a table or on a ramp. Basset Hounds are expected to be judged on the ramp during breed judging. For the judging of Juniors, the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp breeds. This list may be revised from time to time, and the current list can be found on the AKC website in Judging Operations. A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the Show Superintendent/Show Secretary prior to the day of the show. AKC approval is not required. Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

- Dachshunds (Smooth):** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Miniature (under 11 lbs. & 12 mos. old or over); Standard (11 lbs. & over and under 11 lbs. if less than 12 mos. old). Open Standard Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black & Tan including any other color except Red; Red.
- Dachshunds (Wirehaired):** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Miniature (under 11 lbs. & 12 mos. old or over); Standard (11 lbs. & over and under 11 lbs. if less than 12 mos. old).
- Boxers:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Brindle; Fawn.
- Bullmastiffs:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Brindle; Any Other Allowed Color.
- Doberman Pinschers:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black; Any Other Allowed Color.
- Great Danes:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black, Blue, Brindle, Fawn, Harlequin, Mantle.
- St. Bernards:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Longhaired; Shorthaired.
- Pugs:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black, Fawn.
- Boston Terriers:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Under 15 lbs., 15 lbs. and Under 20 lbs; 20 lbs. and not to exceed 25 lbs.
- Chinese Shar-Pei:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Brush Coat; Horse Coat.
- Chow Chows:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black, Red, Any Other Color.
- Australian Shepherds:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black; Blue Merle; Red; Red Merle.
- Collies (Rough):** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Blue Merle; Sable & White; Tri-Color; White.
- Shetland Sheepdogs:** Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Sable & White; Any Other Allowed Color.

The Parks Department that maintains the Walla Walla Park in Wenatchee has informed the Wenatchee Kennel Club that this will be the last year we can hold the Dog Show at this park unless damage to the Ball Fields is dramatically reduced. Therefore these are rules that will be enforced.

1. Very large motor homes may be parked on the Northeast asphalt parking lot.
2. All recreational vehicles that use stabilizing jacks are required use at least an 18 inch by 18 inch board or equivalent between the Jack and the grass to prevent putting holes in the grass.
3. No exhaust from generators or the vehicle engine should be pointed to the grass for any length of time. Generator exhaust needs to be vented upward. In other words do not burn the grass from generator or engine exhaust.
4. Do not dump any liquids on the grass. If you use a bucket with Chlorine or Pine Sol type water for pooper scoopers, do not dump on the grass.
5. If your dog digs while in an exercise pen, then put down a mat or other barrier to prevent destroying the grass.
6. Ball Field 4 at the Northwest corner will only be used for overflow vehicles to reduce ruts in Ball Field 3 in the Southwest corner.
7. We may require extra vehicles to be parked in the day parking lots.




