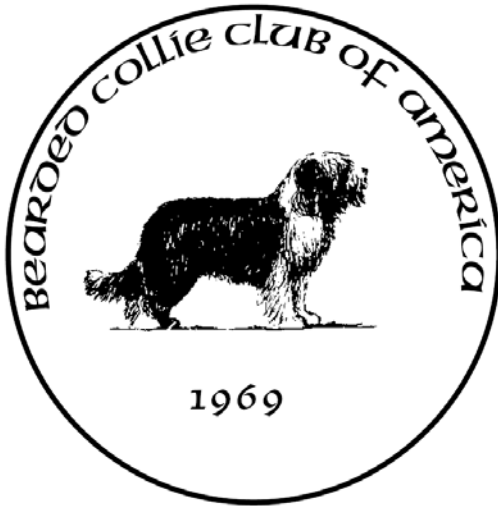

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- Effective for all events held on and after January 1, 2008, The American Kennel Club will collect a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. The current 50 cent recording fee will continue to be collected where applicable. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for The American Kennel Club. These event service and recording fees shall be forwarded to The American Kennel Club along with all other required event results within seven (7) days of the close of the event.
- CANADIAN CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS MUST BE DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS, AND/OR MADE PAYABLE IN U.S. FUNDS
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries. There is no refund for bitches in season in Obedience.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge of \$20.00 will be added. FAX NUMBER: (360) 683-6654. This is for Fax Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). A Fax-Friendly entry blank PDF is available for download at www.BaRayEvents.com
- ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify BaRay Events at (360) 683-1507 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. BaRay Events will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent/Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- TROPHIES & PRIZES will be awarded in the ring to person exhibiting the dog. No awards will be mailed.
- ALL RIGHTS TO TELEVISION, VIDEOTAPE, ADVERTISE, PHOTOGRAPH, PROMOTE or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

NOTE: *As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace Class is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.*

AMATEUR OWNER HANDLER – The Amateur-Owner-Handler Class shall be for dogs that are at least 6 mos of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Ch. 11, Sec. 13).

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASSES – For dogs that are:

- Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show;
- Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show;
- Individually registered with The American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show;
- Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as the date of the closing of entries for the show.

The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES – For dogs and bitches, six months of age or over, that have been neutered or spayed. The dog and bitch winning these classes are not eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

HERDING TITLED CLASSES – For dogs and bitches, 6 months of age and over, that have earned an AKC herding title. The title qualifying the dog to be entered in this class must have been earned

and verified by AKC no later than the show's Closing Date. Dogs entered in these classes must not have been neutered or spayed. By virtue of winning these classes, the dog and bitch are eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

PERFORMANCE CLASSES – For dogs and bitches, 6 months of age and over, that have earned at least one title in any AKC Performance Event (Agility, Herding, Obedience, Rally or Tracking. Dogs entered in these classes must not have been neutered or spayed. By virtue of winning these classes, the dog and bitch are eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

VETERAN CLASSES – For dogs and bitches seven years of age and older. In accordance with Chapter 11, Section 8, veteran dogs and bitches may be spayed or neutered at specialty shows. First place winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes will compete for Best Veteran Dog and Best Veteran Bitch. The dog and bitch winning Best Veteran Dog and Best Veteran Bitch are eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION – Undefeated dogs ONLY are eligible to compete for Best of Breed. All Best of Breed Dogs will be judged to their entirety. Bitches do not need to come into the ring to be checked at this point. The Best of Breed Bitch judging will follow to their entirety. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

GRAND CHAMPION COMPETITION – The following categories of dogs are entered in this competition:

1. Dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed or Best of Variety class.
2. Dogs transferred to Best of Breed/Variety which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed.
3. Champions that win Non-Regular Classes and become eligible for Best of Breed competition. (Altered or spayed CH veteran class winners at independent specialties are eligible.)
4. Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition.

At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to:

1. Best of Breed or Variety
2. Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed or Variety
3. Select Dog
4. Select Bitch

Grand Champion competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed competition.

AWARDS OF MERIT – The Bearded Collie Club of America, Inc. will offer up to fifteen (15) Awards of Merit to all dogs competing in the Best of Breed competition for deserved recognition of quality breed characteristics, to be awarded at the officiating judge's discretion. The rosettes are numbered 1 through 15. The distribution of Award of Merit rosettes in the Best of Breed competition at the National Specialty will be as follows: The Award of Merit rosettes are to be awarded in sequential order of the judge's preference. Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex do not receive Award of Merit placing.

STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dogs and two (2) of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered individually in one of the Regular Classes, Herding Titled Classes, (provided the Get has not been spayed or neutered), Performance Classes or Best of Breed Competition.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as Stud Dog, except substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and "Produce" for "Get". Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that a "castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

BRACE CLASS – Two identical ownership, regardless of sex. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc. Please submit Brace entries together.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Judge: Claudia McNulty

This Sweepstakes is open to all Bearded Collies who on the day of the show will be 6 months and under 20 months of age. All entries in the Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular Class in this show at the appropriate entry fee. Champions of record may be entered in Sweepstakes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and "Age Division" on the regular entry form under Additional Classes.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
