FROM THE SACRAMENTO AIRPORT: Take I-5 south to Garden Highway exit. Exit and turn left at the light onto Garden Highway. Take Garden Highway to Arden Way. Stay on Arden Way until you come to the Arden Fair Mall. Turn left into the Arden Fair Mall in front of Sears. Take an immediate left onto the frontage road and follow it around to the hotel.

FROM THE WEST / SAN FRANCISCO BAY AREA (I-80): Take I-80 East to Highway 50 (South Lake Tahoe) to Capital City Freeway. Follow Capital City Freeway East towards Reno. Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

VETERAN DOG VETERAN BITCH

A class for Dogs and a class for Bitches, 7 years of age and older. Dogs/bitches entered in Veterans need not be intact. Winners, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible for Best of Breed competition.

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION – The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. Selects, if applicable, will be chosen following Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES)

Note: As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class." While the merits of the stud dog or brood bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog/brood bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed.

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and at least two but no more than four of their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular class.

Brood Bitch Class: For Brood Bitches and at least two but no more than four of their Produce. Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not necessarily be owner of the produce. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular class.

Brace Class: Two dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and all must be individually entered in another class. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

Team Class: Same rules as for Brace Class, except substitute Four Dogs for Two Dogs.

SWEEPSTAKES

Requirements – Sweepstakes is open to all dogs that, on the day of the show, will be six months of age and under 18 months of age. Champions of Record are eligible, provided they are otherwise qualified. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the Regular classes with the regular entry form. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for Additional Class.

- Exercise dogs **ONLY** in the designated areas. Please clean up after exercising your dogs; equipment will be available for your convenience. Waste must be deposited in poop buckets provided by the club. If the area you are in does not have a bucket, it is **NOT** an exercise area.
- The Grooming Area is a privilege extended by the Chow Chow Club, Inc. and the Host Hotel, which can and will be withdrawn from those who do not follow the instructions and rules of the Show Committee. Grooming allowed in designated areas only. A spacious grooming area will be provided. **NO BATHING AND GROOMING OF DOGS ALLOWED IN HOTEL ROOMS, hallways or ballrooms.** If there is any grooming found by the Hotel Staff or Show Committee in these areas, you will be asked to leave.

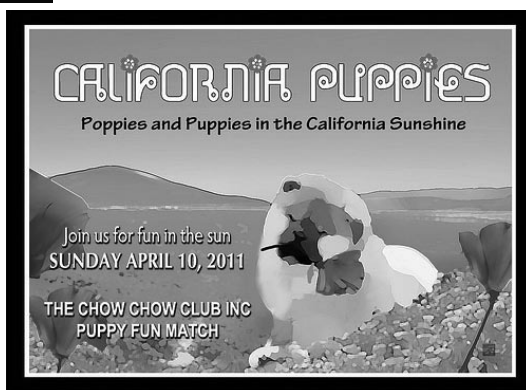

Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks.
