The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- Effective for all events held on and after Jan. 1, 2008, The American Kennel Club will collect a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. The current 50 cent recording fee will continue to be collected where applicable. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for The AKC. These event service and recording fees shall be forwarded to The AKC along with all other required event results within seven (7) days of the close of the event.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$25.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries. There is no refund for bitches in season in Obedience.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge of \$20.00 will be added. FAX NUMBER: (360) 683-6654. This is for Fax Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). - Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify BaRay Events at (360) 683-1507 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. BaRay Events will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. - Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.

A neutered male or spayed bitch may be entered in Veterans. Winners of the above classes, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible to compete in Best of Breed competition.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owners' records. Select Dog and/or Select Bitch, where applicable, will be chosen following Best of Breed

AWARDS OF MERIT: In addition to selecting Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, the judge can select up to three (3) Awards of Merit.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving multiple dog entries)

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and two of their get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch or Brace Class is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

SPECIAL CLASS

Sexually Altered Dogs Sexually Altered Bitches

Class is open to any dog or bitch that is 6 months of age or older at the time of this show and that has been neutered. Trimmed dogs are permissible. Special classes will immediately precede the commencement of regular conformation classes. Dogs and bitches will compete separately and winners will not be eligible for further judging.

THIS IS A SELF-CLEANING EVENT and clean-up equipment is provided. Any exhibitor observed failing to clean up may be subject to disciplinary action. Two wheeled scooters, motorized or other, are not allowed on the Fairgrounds. **FOR YOUR SAFETY, NO STROLLERS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE JUDGING BUILDINGS.**

- **OUTDOOR SETUPS** are permitted only beyond 20 feet of all show rings and where they do not cause congestion or block access to the ring. Safety regulations and limited space prohibits setups in day of show parking lots.
- **INSIDE ANACAPA AND SAN MIGUEL HALLS** (judging buildings) all setups must be within area bounded by walls and the taped line. To accommodate as many exhibitors as possible, only one exercise pen is permitted per setup. **BLOW DRYERS OR VACUUMS are NOT ALLOWED** to be used in these buildings nor may dogs be left there overnight.
- **GROOMING AREAS** are provided in Santa Cruz Hall where power is adequate for blowers. This building is designated solely for grooming and setup It is not available for other functions such as group lunches, raffles and club meetings.

PARKING INFORMATION

All parking is at your own risk. Seaside Park and the show-giving clubs assume no responsibility for loss or damage to vehicles or their contents.

DAY PARKING: Seaside Park will collect a fee of \$5.00 per car and parking will be in designated lots only. A controlled loading zone is provided; vehicles must be removed promptly. Lights must be left on and keys in the ignition while vehicle is in the loading zone.

OVERNIGHT PARKING is a privilege extended by the Summerfest Cluster. It may be withdrawn from any person who does not abide by the rules or who uses abusive language or tactics. Authorized personnel will assist parking all motor homes. All vehicles must have a working fire extinguisher, be self-contained and no discharging of holding tanks is allowed at Seaside Park.

- No electrical cords will be permitted across paths or roadways. UNAUTHORIZED PLUGGING- INTO ANY OUTLETS ON THE GROUNDS MAY RESULT IN SEVERANCE OF ATTACHED CORD. Any persons who break open lock boxes or otherwise damages property in order to find electricity will be held financially responsible; will be subject to an event committee hearing and asked to leave. Fees will not be refunded.
- No running of generators between 10 PM and 6 AM
- Those wishing to park together must send request and full fee together in same envelope, however there is no guarantee we can accommodate all requests.
- Spaces are approximately 25' X 40'. Any vehicle or combination of vehicles greater than 40' must reserve two spaces.
- Tagalong vehicles will be charged per night. Those not fitting in the parking space allocated will be required to park elsewhere.
- Riding other modes of transportation, with the exception of legitimately licensed handicapped units, are not allowed on the fair grounds. This includes: scooters, motorized or not, roller blades, skateboards, bicycles, tricycles or any other wheeled object. California has not approved 2 wheeled handicapped vehicles.
- All RV parking is on asphalt and conveniently located; there is no designated handicapped parking.
