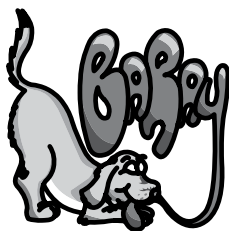

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION – The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records. Select Dog and Select Bitch will be awarded following Best of Breed.

AWARDS OF MERIT – At the Judge's discretion up to 10% of the entered dogs may be awarded Awards of Merit. Rosettes are offered for recipients of Awards of Merit

NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Entrants in the Veteran Classes need not be intact. Spayed and neutered animals are eligible. Winners of the above Non-Regular Single Dog classes, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

As the judges decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible for Best of Breed Competition by virtue of having won any of these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dogs and at least two of their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular class. An entry fee of \$28.00 will be charged for the Stud Dog if he is NOT entered in one of the Regular Classes, Non-Regular Classes or for Best of Breed Competition. Entry fee for Stud Dog as an additional class is \$22.00.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as above except substitute Brood Bitch For Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS – Two dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class." An entry fee of \$28.00 will be charged for the Brace as a UNIT if either dog is NOT entered in one of the Regular Classes, Non-Regular Classes or for Best of Breed Competition. Entry fee for Brace as a UNIT as an additional class is \$22.00.

**SPECIAL ATTRACTION – FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION
STCA NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY**

This will be held during a break at the conclusion of the regular judging of dog classes.

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin. All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol. Entries are to be made on an official AKC Entry Blank. Pre-entries will be accepted by BaRay Events until Friday, October 7. After this time, you must contact the Show Secretary on site to enter. Entries will be taken until 9:00AM on the day of the event at the Show Secretary's desk.

NATIONAL FUTURITY

General:

1. 30 % to operating expense fund. In the event there are any remaining funds: All left over funds will be submitted to the Challenge Trophy Award fund.
2. 70% to be divided equally between the puppy and junior stakes.

Division of individual; stake moneys (Puppy & Junior)

1. 80% to placements in the eight classes, pro-rated by the number of dogs entered in each class, 40% to 1st, 30% to 2nd, 20% to 3rd, & 10% to 4th.
2. 7% to be divided equally between the two age divisions reserve winners (puppy & junior) with 3½% going to each.
3. 3% to be divided equally between the two age division reserve winners with 1½ going to each.
4. 10% to Best in Futurity Stakes

Division of Prize Money

1. 40% to Breeder
2. 30% to Owner
3. 30% to Stud Dog Owner
4. Both Breeder and owners must be members of the STCA for eligibility.

Trophies & Ribbons

1. A trophy and rosette will be provided for Best Puppy, Best Junior, and Best in Futurity winner from the Futurity operating funds.
2. Other trophies and rosettes may be awarded at the discretion of the National Specialty Futurity Committee.
3. Ribbons will be awarded for each placement.

***Best in Futurity winner & breeders name will be engraved on a wooden plaque each year of the futurity.*

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- Effective for all events held on and after Jan. 1, 2008, The American Kennel Club will collect a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. The current 50 cent recording fee will continue to be collected where applicable. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for The AKC. These event service and recording fees shall be forwarded to The AKC along with all other required event results within seven (7) days of the close of the event.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$25.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries. There is no refund for bitches in season in Obedience.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge of \$20.00 will be added. FAX NUMBER: (360) 683-6654. This is for Fax Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). A Fax-Friendly entry blank PDF is available for download at www.BaRayEvents.com
- Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify BaRay Events at (360) 683-1507 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. BaRay Events will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. - Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- No flexi leads allowed on the show grounds during judging.
