BEST OF BREED COMPETITION – The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. Selects, if applicable, will be chosen following Best of Breed.

Following Best of Breed Judging there will be competition for:

Best Puppy from the Puppy Classes, Best Bred by Exhibitor, Best Veteran, Best Phalene

AWARDS OF MERIT: At the discretion of the Judge, up to five (5) Awards of Merit to be awarded to dogs or bitches exhibited in Best of Breed Competition.

AMATEUR-OWNER-HANDLER CLASS: The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: Bred by Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (revised 09/02)• All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

VETERAN DOG, 7 Yrs. & under 10 Yrs. VETERAN BITCH, 7 Yrs. & under 10 Yrs.

VETERAN DOG, 10 Yrs. & Older VETERAN BITCH, 10 Yrs. & Older

Dogs/bitches entered in Veterans need not be intact.

Winners, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible for Best of Breed competition.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Note: As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and at least two and no more than five of their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular class.

Brood Bitch Class: For Brood Bitches and at least two and no more than five of their Produce. Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not necessarily be owner of the produce. While the merits of the brood bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the brood bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular class.

Brace Class: Two dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

Pre-Novice Class. The Pre-Novice Class shall be for dogs that have not received a third qualifying score in a Novice Class prior to the closing of the trial. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. However, if a person has handled more than one dog in the first four exercises, that person must provide a handler for the additional dog in the same Group Exercise.

Veterans Class. The Veterans Class will be for dogs that have an obedience title and are at least 6 years old on the date of the trial. The exercises will be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. Dogs may be entered in another class or classes.

Brace Class. The Brace Class will be for two dogs of the same breed that are eligible under these Regulations and capable of performing the Novice exercises. The dogs need not be owned by the same person but will be handled by one handler. A separate official entry form will be completed in full for each dog entered.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice class. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

SPECIAL ATTRACTIONS

PARADE OF TITLEHOLDERS – SATURDAY, MARCH 31, 2012

Dogs entered in this class may or may not be entered in a Regular class of this show, however, all dogs must be holders of either an American Kennel Club Champion of Record Title and/or American Kennel Club performance event title. The class will not be judged and each entry will receive the special prize of a rosette imprinted with the dog's name. A biography of the dog, up to 200 words MUST be included with the entry form. Entry fee \$30.00.

RESCUE PARADE – SATURDAY, MARCH 31, 2012

Papillons entered in this class may or may not be entered in a Regular class of this show, however, all dogs must come from a rescue organization. The class will not be judged. A biography of the dog, up to 200 words MUST be included with the entry form. Entry fee (NO CHARGE).

OVER 60 HANDLER COMPETITION (EXHIBITION ONLY) – FRIDAY, MARCH 30, 2012

Calling all Handlers 60 and older. There is now a class just for you. Costumes or props are allowed on both you and/or your dog, as long as they do not inhibit the exhibitor or cause others any harm. Any purebred Papillon or Phalene can be entered that is over 6 mos of age. Please enter the name of the Handler and the dog.

TROPHIES & PRIZES

Trophies and prizes (including cash prizes) will be awarded in the judging rings to the person exhibiting the dog, who will be considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. All claims for trophies and other prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed, and the Show Chairperson advised at once in the event of any discrepancy. No awards will be mailed. The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

CHALLENGE TROPHIES

For permanent possession Challenge Trophies must be won three times by the same owner, but not necessarily with the same dog, nor at consecutive shows. Challenge trophies will remain in the possession of the Papillon Club of America, Inc. until retired.


