

– NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS –

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- Effective for events held on and after January 1, 2004, the AKC will collect a \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. The current 50 cent recording fee will continue to be collected. A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for the AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Event/Recording Fees to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).
- **CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS**
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**. The Club and/or its Superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. **RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.**
- Entry fees shall **NOT** be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS**. The Superintendent will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show **NO REFUND** will be made.
- **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE.** The Superintendent will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY BASIS**.
- **REFUNDS** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent **AFTER THE SHOW**. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP SUBSTITUTION OF DOG.** There will be an Administrative Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show.
- Only dogs eligible for this show will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- The judging will start promptly. Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their time of judging, and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.
- **ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED** after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor **NOT** receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, **PLEASE** notify the Superintendent at (360) 683-1507 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.
- **LOSS OR DAMAGE** – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.

Additional divisions (age, color or weight) are in the breed list and must be indicated on the entry form.

All dogs entered in the Bred By Exhibitor Class must be **individually registered** with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog AND an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder AND owner of record.

A class for dogs and a class for bitches seven (7) years of age and under 10 years of age.

VETERAN DOGS CLASS II VETERAN BITCHES CLASS II

A class for dogs and a class for bitches 10 years of age and over.

Note: Veteran Class entrants MUST be intact. Spayed or neutered dogs/bitches are not eligible. Winners of the Veterans Classes, if otherwise undefeated at this show, are eligible to compete for Best of Breed/Variety.

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If at the end of the 90 day period the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC."

Dachshunds (Smooth): Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Miniature (under 11 lbs. & 12 mos. old or over); Standard (11 lbs. & over and under 11 lbs. if less than 12 mos. old). Open Standard Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black & Tan including any other color except Red; Red.

Dachshunds (Wirehaired): Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Miniature (under 11 lbs. & 12 mos. old or over); Standard (11 lbs. & over and under 11 lbs. if less than 12 mos. old).

Boxers: Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Brindle; Fawn.

Bullmastiffs: Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Brindle; Any Other Allowed Color.

Doberman Pinschers: Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black; Any Other Allowed Color.

Great Danes: Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Brindle, Fawn, Blue, Black, Harlequin, Mantle.

St. Bernards: Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Longhaired; Shorthaired.

Pugs: Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black, Fawn.
