NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The AKC will collect a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on each entry of a dog, and 50 cent Recording Fee for the first entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule. Ch.11, Sec. 2). In accordance with AKC Rally regulations, the AKC will collect a \$3.00 per entry of dog Rally Event Service Fee. A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for AKC.
- **CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS**
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**. The Club and/or its Superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. **RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.**
- **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE.** The Superintendent will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY BASIS**.
- **REFUNDS** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent **AFTER THE SHOW**. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- **FAX ENTRIES** – Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge of \$20.00 will be added. **FAX NUMBER: (360) 683-6654.** This is for Fax Machine **ONLY**. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). A Fax-Friendly entry blank PDF is available for download at www.BarayEvents.com
- **ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED** after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor **NOT** receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, **PLEASE** notify the Superintendent at (360) 683-1507 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.
- Entry fees shall **NOT** be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES** or **OVERPAYMENTS**. The Superintendent will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show **NO REFUND** will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these events will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- **LOSS OR DAMAGE** – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- **TROPHIES & PRIZES** will be awarded in the ring to the person exhibiting the dog. No awards will be mailed.
- **ALL RIGHTS TO TELEVISION, VIDEOTAPE, ADVERTISE, PHOTOGRAPH, PROMOTE** or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons and animals on the Show Grounds at any time while the show is in progress, do by attending this show or participating therein, grant to the Club the right to photograph, televise, videotape, audiotape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent. The Club is not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP – Basenjis, Basset Hounds, Whippets

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice class. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED FOR BASENJIS AND WHIPPETS ONLY:

Junior – 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show;

Intermediate – 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show;

Senior – 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE in the Junior Showmanship Classes.

NON-REGULAR MULTIPLE DOG CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

STUD DOG CLASS – OFFERED FOR BASENJIS, BASSET HOUNDS, IRISH WOLFHOUNDS, WHIPPETS

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – OFFERED FOR BASENJIS, BASSET HOUNDS, IRISH WOLFHOUNDS, WHIPPETS

For Brood Bitches and their Produce. Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not necessarily be owner of the produce. While the merits of the brood bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the brood bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular class.

BRACE CLASS – OFFERED FOR BASENJIS, BASSET HOUNDS, IRISH WOLFHOUNDS, WHIPPETS

Two dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

TEAM CLASS – OFFERED FOR IRISH WOLFHOUNDS

Four dogs, performing in unison. All rules applying to Brace Class apply to Team Class.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE Animals left in vehicles will be monitored by County Control Officers and Club Members. If animals are in distress due to heat or any other circumstance, the vehicle will be forcibly entered, the animal recovered and the owner cited.

CATALOG ADVERTISING GUIDELINES

These guidelines apply to both Black & White and Color Ads (if offered)

HARD COPY ADS: All text must be typewritten or legibly printed. Photos should be photographic quality, not printed from an inkjet or bubblejet printer.

ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION FORMATS:

- High resolution PDF (press quality) (preferred format)
- JPG or TIF (300 pixels/inch resolution)
- Word document built on LEGAL template (not letter) (note, fonts may default)

The following are NOT acceptable formats: PowerPoint, Works, Excel, Word Perfect, Publisher Ads MUST be built in proportion to a catalog page. Image area is 4.5"x7.25", including any border. Be aware, if you build your ad 8.5x11, it will be shrunk to fit a catalog page, and will not be in proportion to the page. If you build your ad 13 inches long on a LEGAL Word template, that will be acceptable and in proportion.

It is recommended that you burn a CD of any of your electronic ads and submit that to the ad chairman for your specialty. CD should be readable in both PC and MAC format.

CANOPIES FOR SHADE ARE ALLOWED but, per AKC rules, must be positioned 10 feet from any ring. A clear walkway will be maintained around the rings. **THERE IS NO SHADE ON THESE GROUNDS. Please bring your own shade and chairs.**

A class for Dogs and a class for Bitches seven years and under ten years.

VETERAN SENIOR DOGS VETERAN SENIOR BITCHES

A class for Dogs and a class for Bitches ten years of age and older.

FIELD CHAMPION DOGS FIELD CHAMPION BITCHES

For those dogs and bitches who have earned an AKC or ASFA Field Championship. Entrants may be spayed or neutered, but will not be allowed to continue on to Best of Breed if they win this class.

Winners of the above classes, if otherwise undefeated at this show, will compete for Best of Breed.

NOTE: Dogs defeated in these classes may not compete for Best of Breed even if they were additionally entered in the Best of Breed class. (No championship points are awarded for these classes.)

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owners' records.

FRIDAY ONLY – Veterans Exhibition: (13 years old and over) Dogs must be AKC registered. Class will follow Veteran's Classes, but dogs entered in this class are **NOT eligible for BOB competition**. Dog may be presented for examination at owner's discretion. **Entry should be accompanied by a 3x5-card description of the dog's lifetime achievements to be read in ring by the steward.**

Non-Regular Classes (Involving multiple dog entries) – Offered Friday Only

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and a minimum of two, and no more than four of their Get. *See class definition, Page 4.*

BROOD BITCH CLASS: For Brood Bitches and a minimum of two, and no more than four of their Produce. *See class definition, Page 4.*

BRACE CLASS: *See class definition, Page 4.*

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, or Brace Class is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION – BOTH DAYS See class definition, Page 3.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the substitute dog is not entered in this specialty, the Junior Showmanship only fee applies.
