Coursing Classes are for Dogs and Bitches that are AKC registered and are confirmed Lure Coursing Champions or Open Field Champions. Titles must be from a recognized coursing organization. NOTE: Exhibitors must supply proof of eligibility for the class entry. First place winners are eligible for Best of Breed Competition provided all AKC eligibility requirements have been met.

Dogs entered in Veterans and Coursing may be spayed or neutered. No winners from these classes can receive championship points.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records.

SELECT DOG SELECT BITCH

Award of Merit – At a Specialty often times the number of quality dogs in competition far exceeds the number of top awards available. The Judge may, at his discretion, present Award of Merit rosettes to Dogs and/or Bitches who have competed in the Best of Breed judging. Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch are not included in the competition for these Awards.

SCOA Specialty, Thursday...Up to 4 Awards of Merit

NCSF Specialties, Friday & Saturday...Up to 2 Awards of Merit each day

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

STUD DOG. For Stud Dogs and at least two and no more than three of their get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH. Same as above except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and produce for get.

BRACE CLASS: Two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace **MUST** be named at the time of entry. If a dog, which is to be part of a Brace, is not entered in any of the Regular Classes or for Best of Breed Competition, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only." An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes. "Brace Class." Entry Fee for the Unit is \$20.00 in addition to any other fees paid for the individual dogs.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, not one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

The Sweepstakes is open to all Salukis who are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age at the time of the Specialty. All dogs entered in a Sweepstakes class must also be entered in a Regular Class or for Best of Breed Competition at this Specialty, at the regular entry fee.

SPECIALTY CLUB PARKING AND GROOMING

PARKING & GROOMING SUPERVISED BY SAMMAMISH KENNEL CLUB AND ITS DESIGNEES
