Entrants in Veterans need not be intact. Winners of the Veterans Classes, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible to compete in Best of Breed competition.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION – The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. Selects will be chosen following Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES)

Note: As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular class. Entry Fee \$28.00 as original entry, or \$18.00 as additional entry.

Brood Bitch Class: For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not necessarily be owner of the produce. While the merits of the brood bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the brood bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular class. Entry Fee \$28.00 as original entry, or \$18.00 as additional entry.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 4:00PM Thursday, June 20, 2013. **NO CRATES OR EXERCISE PENS ARE ALLOWED ON THE GRASS, IN OR AROUND THE SHOW RINGS.** Crates **ONLY** may be taken to ringside during the judging of the breed. All crates **MUST BE REMOVED** upon completion of breed judging. **TENTS OR CANOPIES MAY BE SET UP ON FRIDAY ONLY.** Be sure to keep aisle ways clear. A designated grooming area will be provided. The grooming area is indoors. All fire lanes must be kept clear. **NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT IN THE GROOMING AREA OVERNIGHT.** Cars may drive to the grooming area to unload (10 minute maximum) starting at 4:00PM on Thursday. All vehicles must return to the **DAY PARKING AREA.**

SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes and is open to all Great Pyrenees who, on the day of the show, are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. All entries in Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in a regular class or Best of Breed at this show. Entry fee is for each dog and entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as the Regular Classes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and the age division in the space provided for "Additional Classes." Sweepstakes entries may be shown by anyone in good standing with the AKC. Champions of record are eligible to compete. Entry fee is \$18.00.

Classes will be divided by age and sex. Each dog or bitch NEED NOT be entered in a Regular Class at the show. All class winners (up to 6) will compete together for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Reserve Best in Veteran Sweepstakes, regardless of sex. Entry fee is \$18.00 for each dog and entries shall be made on a regular entry form. Indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" and the age division in the space provided for "Additional Classes." Dogs and bitches which have been altered (castrated or spayed) may be entered. Entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes may be shown by anyone in good standing with the American Kennel Club

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The American Kennel Club will collect: a \$3.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee where applicable for the first entry of a dog, plus a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for The American Kennel Club. These event service and recording fees shall be forwarded to The American Kennel Club along with all other required event results within seven (7) days of the close of the event.
- No entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club, its On-Site Secretary and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$25.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries. There is no refund for bitches in season in Obedience.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge of \$20.00 will be added. FAX NUMBER: (360) 683-6654. This is for Fax Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). A Fax-Friendly entry blank PDF is available for download at www.BarayEvents.com
- Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify BaRay Events at (360) 683-1507 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. BaRay Events will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 11, Section 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent/Show Secretary

will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- **Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.**
- All Trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

- Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over and the Show Secretary advised at once. The Club, On-Site Secretary, and/or BaRay Events disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.
- All dogs must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising pen.
- There shall be no drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.
- All dogs shall be kept on leash except when in the obedience or agility ring.
- No Flexi Leads or Halter-type collars or pinch collars on the show grounds.
- Exhibitors are responsible for maintaining clean conditions in and around their crates/set-up.
- All regulations governing the use of the event facility and all regulations and decisions of the Event Committee will be strictly enforced, including any not recorded in this Premium List.
- All persons attending this event hereby waive any claim for damages against the Club, their members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.


DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE – CLACKAMAS COUNTY EVENT CENTER

Southbound: Take I-205 from north of Vancouver to exit #9, Oregon City. Follow signs to 99E, which goes through Oregon City to Canby (it's about 8 miles from Oregon City to Canby). You can see the Event Center to the right as you approach Canby. Look for Event Center road signs.

OR

Continue southbound on I-5 through the Portland metropolitan area and take exit #282A, Canby-Hubbard. Turn slight right onto Hubbard Cutoff Road NE/Wilsonville Hubbard Hwy. Turn Left onto Amdt Road NE. Stay straight to go onto South Knights Bridge Road. Turn Right onto North Grant Street. Turn Left onto NW 4th Street. Continue on NW 4th Street, which becomes NE 4th Avenue to the Event Center.

Northbound: Take the Exit 278 toward the Aurora National Historic District/Donald from I-5, turn right at the bottom of the exit ramp on to Ehlen Road NE. Ehlen Road NE becomes 1st Street NE. Stay straight to go onto Liberty Street NE. Turn LEFT onto OR 99E/Pacific Hwy. East to Canby (about 4 miles). Go to the north end of town and follow FAIRGROUNDS signs to the show (to your left from 99E).

ENTRIES, CANCELLATIONS, CHANGES, TRANSFERS

FAX ENTRIES: Fax number: 360-683-6654. \$4.00 per dog per show added for FAX-Credit Card entries. Both sides of entry form must be transmitted. Entries must be accompanied by a cover sheet stating the number of pages, what shows and how many dogs per show. Visa, MasterCard, and American Express are accepted for Fax entries.
