RV PARKING RULES & INFORMATION:

- Reservations must be received on or before June 10, 2013. Your signature is required on the form to be a valid application. PLEASE MAIL EARLY Payment is due in full at the time of reservation.
- RV map with overnight assigned spaces will be posted at the Main Entrance. If you arrive late, please find your assigned space number next to your name.
- Please be courteous to all parking and grounds staff as they are all volunteers. Also, please be respectful of your RV neighbors so everyone enjoys their stay.
- All RVs must be self contained. Anyone dumping gray water/sewage on grounds will be subject to a fine. We are hoping to arrange a mid-week dump on site through the porta-potty provider for a nominal fee and will have more details in the future.
- There is an RV dump site located in town at the Auburn Eagles Lodge for a requested donation of \$5. This location is on the way to/from Argus Ranch not far off the highway.
- Generator running times: 6 AM to 10 PM - QUIET Hours 10PM-6 AM
- Requests to park together MUST arrive together in the same envelope.
- Power/water requests are on a first come, first served basis according to space available for size of vehicle. There are spaces available with power/water hookups some distance from the ring. You will need to park in your assigned space.
- Reservation confirmation will be made via email. If you are NOT contacted, you do not have a reservation. Email jennifer@bantubasenjis.com with any questions.
- Generators are available through various rental companies in the Auburn area and are required for running air conditioning in your rig. A/C units are NOT to be run on Argus Ranch power! Please be courteous of this rule so no one experiences a power outage during their stay.
- RV parking in the large field area cannot begin until after completion of all lure coursing events on Saturday afternoon.
- RV parking WITHOUT a reservation will be \$50 at the gate if parking is still available.
- Additional vehicle may be parked in front of your RV at no additional charge as space allows.
- All RV parking will be on either gravel or grass surfaces. Tent camping will be on grass surfaces. X-pens and pop-ups are allowed within your reserved space.
- Mens and Womens shower and bathroom facilities are available on site in Brutus Hall.
- Several areas are available on site to exercise dogs. Please clean up after your hounds and obey any posted signs requiring dogs to be leashed.
- Please clean your area before leaving the show grounds so that we can continue to have shows at this wonderful facility.
