

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The American Kennel Club will collect: a \$3.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee where applicable for the first entry of a dog, plus a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.50 is required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 is required for each additional entry of the same dog. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for The American Kennel Club. These event service and recording fees shall be forwarded to The American Kennel Club along with all other required event results within seven (7) days of the close of the event.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. **RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.**
- **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE.** Baray Events will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$25.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- **REFUNDS** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent **AFTER THE SHOW.** An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries. There is no refund for bitches in season in Obedience or Rally.
- **FAX ENTRIES** – Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge of \$20.00 will be added. **FAX NUMBER:** (360) 683-6654. This is for Fax Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). A Fax-Friendly entry blank PDF is available for download at www.BarayEvents.com
- Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify Baray Events at (360) 683-1507 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES** or **OVERPAYMENTS.** Baray Events will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 11, Section 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent/Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- **LOSS OR DAMAGE** – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Single Dog Entries)

VETERAN DOGS VETERAN BITCHES

A class for Dogs and a class for Bitches seven years of age or older. Winners of these classes, if otherwise undefeated, compete for Best of Breed. Neutered Males and Spayed Bitches may compete in the veterans classes.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION – The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owners' records. Grand Champion Selects, if applicable, will be chosen immediately following Best of Breed. The Select awards have no relationship or correlation to Club Awards of Merit.

AWARDS OF MERIT (up to 5, at judge's discretion)

Sexually Altered Class Dogs Sexually Altered Class Bitches

A class for Neutered Dogs and a class for Spayed Bitches. Class will be judged following Best of Breed competition. Winners of these classes are not eligible for Best of Breed Competition.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving multiple dog entries)

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and two of their get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class.

ENTRY FEE of \$30.00 will be charged for each UNIT (Stud Dog and two get or Brood Bitch and two produce) in addition to the entry fee for the regular classes.

BRACE CLASS: Two dogs. The Dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If both dogs are entered in another class at the show, entry fee for Brace Class as a UNIT is \$30.00. If either or both dogs are not entered in another class at this show, entry fee is \$30 for each unentered dog, plus \$30 for Brace as a UNIT (2 dogs). In making entries for “Brace Class Only” full particulars MUST be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for “Best of Breed Competition” and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, “Brace Class.” If more than one Brace is entered by same owner, dogs comprising EACH BRACE must be designated “Brace No. 1,” “Brace No. 2,” etc.

NOTE: As the judge’s decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch or Brace Class is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

MATURITY CLASS: THREE GENERATIONS, male and/or female, not necessarily owned by one person. Dogs need not have identical ownership. Three generations shown eldest to youngest. Limited to one dog or bitch from each generation. All generations to be entered as a single Unit, mailed at the same time and in the same envelope. Entrants making up the Unit must each be entered on an official AKC entry form with Maturity as an additional class, or Maturity Only. At least one entrant in each Unit MUST be entered in a regular class at this show. Entry fee as a Unit, is \$25. Please note: the generation must be grandparent, parent, puppy (any other combination, such as grandparent and two grandpups is unacceptable.)

FROM I-5 NORTHBOUND OR SOUTHBOUND: In the Federal Way area, take EXIT #142A, 18 EAST, AUBURN, NORTH BEND. Go past the Auburn Way Exit and take the AUBURN-BLACK DIAMOND ROAD EXIT and TURN RIGHT at the stop sign. Then TURN RIGHT onto SE Green Valley Road (just past Neely Mansion). Follow for about 7.5 miles. Turn RIGHT onto 212th Way SE. Continue at ** below.

FROM I-405 SOUTHBOUND: Take EXIT #4, RENTON, ENUMCLAW. Go to the second traffic light and TURN LEFT onto HWY 169, MAPLE VALLEY, ENUMCLAW. Follow this through Maple Valley and 1.5 miles past Black Diamond and TURN RIGHT onto SE Green Valley Road. Take this for 3.5 miles (past the Flaming Geyser State Park) and TURN LEFT onto 212th Way SE. Continue at ** below.

FROM ENUMCLAW NORTHBOUND 169: Go NORTH ON PORTER ST./HWY. 169 (toward Maple Valley and Renton) for 6 miles and TURN LEFT onto SE Green Valley Road. Go about 3.5 miles (past the Flaming Geyser State Park) and TURN LEFT onto 212th Way SE. Continue at ** below.
