BEST OF BREED COMPETITION: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records.

SELECT DOG SELECT BITCH

Award of Merit – At a Specialty often times the number of quality dogs in competition far exceeds the number of top awards available. The Judge may, at his discretion, present up to two Awards of Merit rosettes to Dogs and/or Bitches who have competed in the Best of Breed judging each day. Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch are not included in the competition for these Awards.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

STUD DOG. For Stud Dogs and at least two and no more than three of their get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH. Same as above except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and produce for get. **BRACE CLASS:** Two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog, which is to be part of a Brace, is not entered in any of the Regular Classes or for Best of Breed Competition, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only." An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes. "Brace Class." Entry Fee for the Unit is \$20.00 in addition to any other fees paid for the individual dogs.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, not one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

SPECIALTY CLUB PARKING AND GROOMING

PARKING & GROOMING SUPERVISED BY SAMMAMISH KENNEL CLUB AND ITS DESIGNEES
