WORKING TITLED DOG WORKING TITLED BITCH

Open to any dog or bitch holding a Working Title issued by the Portuguese Water Dog Club of America, Inc. (NOTE: A Junior Water Certificate is NOT a Title). Dogs must be eligible to compete in AKC Conformation in every way. (Spayed and Neutered dogs cannot compete in this class.) The winners of these classes are eligible to compete in Best of Breed competition if otherwise undefeated. **Effective* 2013, the dog must be presented in the Working Titled Class by the same person who handled them to their PWDCA Water Title.

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES)

Note: As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or

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excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular class.

Brood Bitch Class: For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not necessarily be owner of the produce. While the merits of the brood bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the brood bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular class.

Brace Class: Two Portuguese Water Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Each dog must also be entered in another regular or non-regular class for which an entry fee is paid. The entry form must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

Team Class: Four Portuguese Water Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. All dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Each dog entered in Team Class must also be entered in another regular or non-regular class for which an entry fee is paid. The entry form must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Team Class."

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

AWARDS OF MERIT

Other than for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex, a Rosette may be presented by the conformation judge in recognition of Superior Quality. Awards of Merit will be awarded after the selection of Best of Breed (BISS), Best of Opposite Sex (BOSS), Best of Winners (BOW). The first male and female to receive these awards will be the Select Dog and Select Bitch. The Selects will receive Grand Champion Points. No other Award of Merit dogs will receive points of any kind. These Awards Of Merit shall be limited to no more than 10 percent of the total intersex Best of Breed entry, which shall be factored up. For example, 67 total dogs/bitches entered would be equal to 7 Award of Merit awards.

BEST PUPPY

Best Puppy will be selected from the Puppy Class winners following the judging of Best of Breed on Thursday September 12, 2013. If Winners Dog or Winners Bitch is chosen from a Puppy Class, it is automatically Best Puppy of its Sex. If Winners Dog or Winners Bitch is not selected from a Puppy Class, and Reserve Winners Dog or Bitch is selected from a puppy class, that puppy is automatically Best Puppy of its sex. Best Male Puppy and Best Female Puppy will compete for Best Puppy In Show. If Best of Winners or Best of Breed is from the Puppy Class, it is automatically Best Puppy In Show.

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR

First Place Winners in Bred By Exhibitor Dog Class and Bitch Class will compete for Best Bred By Exhibitor in Show following the Best Puppy In Show competition. If Best of Winners or Best of Breed is from the Bred By Exhibitor Class, that dog or bitch is automatically Best Bred By Exhibitor in Show.

BEST VETERAN


