When numeric limit is reached, additional entries will be placed on alternate list. Drawing for run order will be at 7PM, Wednesday, March 16, 2005 at the Secretary's office.

Entries limited to 25 runs per day for the duck trials and 50 runs per day per Judge for sheep.

Event hours 7AM to 5PM or conclusion of the trial. This Trial will be held outdoors regardless of weather.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Test/Trial location will be available from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm each day, or 7:00 am to one hour after conclusion of event.

No unentered dogs (except set-out) will be allowed on site.

Bath/Cool-off tub will be provided. Bring your own shade protection and chairs.

**NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED. LUNCH WILL BE AVAILABLE ON SITE.**

Schedule will be provided.

Bitches in season shall be eligible and will run in order of trial classes, but will be moved to the end of the class in test. ***Please notify the Test Secretary if your bitch is in season.***

**Move ups** – A dog may be moved up to the next class in a test or trial in which it is entered and for which entries have closed when, according to the owner's records, the dog has met the title requirements for the class in which it is entered. A dog may be moved up in the next test or trial, provided that the next level class is available (i.e.: offered in the premium list) and that a Judge is available, and, provided further, that the class is not filled. Notification must be made to the Test/Trial Secretary at least one-half hour before the start of the event. The dog cannot be moved up at the event in which it completes its qualifications for a title, or if the move-up would enter a dog twice under the same Judge

**ALL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB RULES REGARDING CONDUCT WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. No refund for duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the club after closing of entries.**

**RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY.**

No conditional entries will be accepted. Entry forms must be signed. If entries are sent via express service, signature must be waived. A separate entry blank must be completed for each dog entered. Entries not on Official AKC Entry forms and photocopies of Entry Forms without the agreement and Rules are NOT ACCEPTABLE. You can use the same entry form for both days and for more than one class and/or stock as long as all entries are for the same dog.

Owners or their agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the test/trial area. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Proof of Rabies vaccination may be requested.
