Non-Regular Classes (involving multiple dog entries)

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and two of their get. Stud Dogs MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class.

BRACE CLASS: Two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If both dogs are entered in another class at the show, entry fee for Brace Class as a UNIT is \$29.00. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars MUST be given for each dog on individual entry forms. - **NOVICE CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
