Dogs & bitches are eligible to compete if they have one or more AKC Herding Titles (HT, PT,HS, HSAd, HSAs, HSAc, HSBd, HSBs, HSBc, HSCs, HI, HIAd, HIAs HIAc, HIBd HIBs, HIBc, HICs, HX, HXAd, HXAs, HXAc, HXBd, HXBs, HXBc, HXCs, HC) by the close of entries. Herding Instinct Certificates do not meet the eligibility requirements of this class. Neutered dogs & spayed bitches are not eligible to compete, only intact dogs are eligible. Winners, if otherwise undefeated in another class at this specialty, will be eligible to compete in Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

SELECT DOG & SELECT BITCH: Grand Champion Competition — The following categories of dogs are entered in this competition: 1. Dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed or Best of Variety class. 2. Dogs transferred to Best of Breed/Variety which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. 3. Champions that win Non-Regular Classes and become eligible for Best of Breed competition. (Altered or spayed CH veteran class winners at independent specialties are eligible.) 4. Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition. At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to: 1. Best of Breed or Variety 2. Best of Opposite 3. Select Dog 4. Select Bitch. Grand Champion competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed competition and in breeds that are divided into varieties, Grand Champion Competition will not continue beyond Best of Variety competition.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

Note: As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular class.

Brood Bitch Class: For Brood Bitches and no less than two nor more than four of their Produce. Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not necessarily be owner of the produce. While the merits of the brood bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the brood bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular class.

Brace Class: For two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be designated "Brace No.1," "Brace No.2"

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

- NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- **OPEN CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice class. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.
- MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Advanced reservation (received by August 5, 2015 deadline) -\$35/night. Late reservation (received after August 5th) or at the gate - \$40/night.

Entrance at the gate will be based on availability. The campground will be closed to the public so you must identify yourself as being with the Evergreen Belgian Teryuren Club dog show.

HOURS – Exhibitors will NOT be admitted before 2:00 p.m. on Thursday August 20th. Check-in for overnight parking also starts at that time. No arrivals will be permitted after 11 p.m. and visitors must leave by 11 p.m. each day. The park opens again for arrivals at 7a.m. Friday and Saturday. Everyone must check out by 1 p.m. on Sunday, August 23rd. Please be considerate of other campers who may want to sleep early.

CAMPGROUND RULES:

From I-5 or Hwy 167, take Hwy 18 EAST bound. Take the Auburn Way/Enumclaw/Hwy 164 East Junction exit. If coming WEST bound on Hwy 18 take the Auburn/Hwy 164 East Junction exit, after milepost 5. At the end of the either ramp, turn LEFT onto Auburn Way South. Continue south on Auburn Way S. At the intersection of M Street, be in the right hand lane in order to take Howard Road (slight right).
