DIRECTIONS TO EMERALD MEADOWS FARM

From I-5 Northbound:

- Take Exist #262 and turn LEFT onto Main Street/Axton Road
- Then Follow directions from I-5 Southbound shown below.
**** OR ****
- Take Exit #257 Northwest Ave.
- Go NORTH on Northwest to Axton Road (4.9 miles).
- Turn RIGHT on Axton to Aldrich Road (1 mile).
- Turn LEFT on Aldrich. Go approximately 1.8 miles.
- Emerald Meadows Farm is on the LEFT. Light green house with big, dark green barn. There will be signs.

From I-5 Southbound:

- Take Exit #262 and go back over the freeway (becomes Axton Road).
- Follow Axton to Aldrich Road (2.8 miles).
- Turn LEFT on Aldrich. Go approximately 1.8 miles.
- Emerald Meadows Farm is on the LEFT. Light green house with big, dark green barn. There will be signs.

From Lynden Border Crossing:

- Take Guide Meridian to the Pole Road.
- Turn RIGHT on Pole Road. Go approximately 1.7 miles.
- Turn LEFT on Aldrich Road. Go approximately 1 mile.
- Emerald Meadows Farm is on the RIGHT. Light green house with big, dark green barn. There will be signs.



Open to all dogs that have completed a JE, SE or ME title.

***Master Earthdog:** 30 feet, three 90 degree turns, with false entrance, den and exit, indication of entrance, honor another working dog. Open to all dogs that have completed a SE or ME title.

ELIGIBILITY

Dogs must be at least 6 months old to enter any class. Dogs registered with the AKC or recorded with the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) of eligible breeds only and dogs that are spayed or neutered or have a Limited Registration, ILP or PAL number may participate.

Only complete entry forms including Registration/ILP/PAL numbers will be accepted.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Bitches in season are not eligible to participate. Entry fees will not be refunded.
- All dogs are to be held on short leash under control while on the test grounds.
- **NO FLEXI-LEADS ALLOWED WITHIN THE YARD, IN THE BUILDINGS OR IN AREAS TO/FROM THE TEST DENS.**
- For everyone's safety, **DOGS SHALL NOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED** in exercise pens.
- Spectators shall be allowed outside the test area if they are quiet and do not distract the dogs.
- No dogs shall be allowed in area immediately adjacent to test areas.
- Please remember that this is a private residence. All attendees must restrict their activity to designated areas and buildings.
- Confirmed entrants not present at the testing area when their number is called will be moved to the end of the class. Master Earth entrants will be declared absent if they do not show within 5 minutes of their brace being called
- All checks must be in U.S. Funds. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Test Secretary shall add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.




